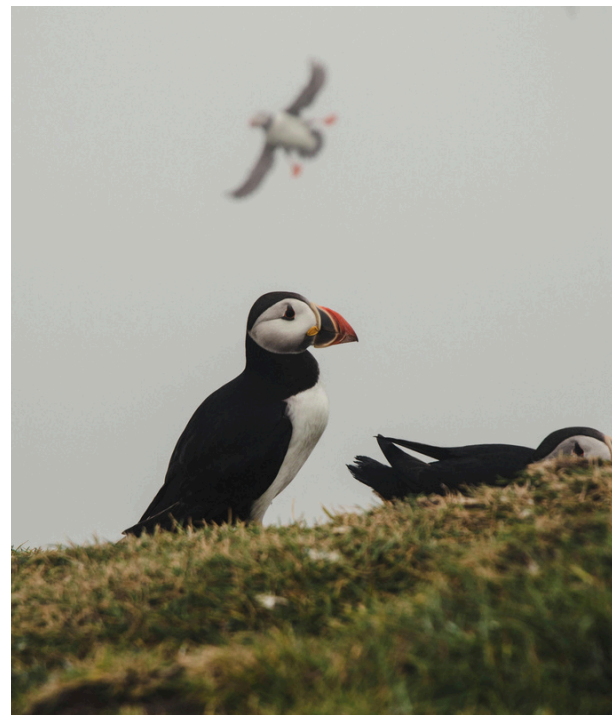

FAROE ISLANDS – NORTH – NORÐOYAR

AMONG REMOTE ISLANDS, LIVING TRADITIONS AND HARSH LANDSCAPES

Norðoyar, the Northern Islands, represent the northernmost edge of the Faroese archipelago, with rugged landscapes and fishing villages steeped in age-old traditions. Here, the air is pure and the sea reigns supreme, while local communities maintain alive their ocean-related crafts and cultural traditions. Small settlements like Klaksvík and Viðareiði offer direct contact with a life still deeply rooted in extreme nature. An authentic place for those wishing to immerse themselves in the roots of a proud and reserved people.

ACCESSIBILITY AND HOSPITALITY

Norðoyar is accessible by ferry and local flights from Tórshavn, with frequent but weather-dependent sea connections. Accommodations are basic but welcoming, with family-run guesthouses and small hotels. Guests are warmly welcomed and often invited to participate in traditional festivals and cultural events. Here, every encounter is an opportunity for exchange and deeper understanding of Faroese culture.

Tórshavn is easily accessible from Vágar International Airport by ferry and road. The city offers a wide range of accommodations, from boutique hotels to modern conference centers. Communities are vibrant and welcoming, ready to share stories and knowledge amidst pristine nature.

ACCESSIBILITY AND HOSPITALITY

The island is accessible by regular ferries and local flights, although less frequently than the rest of the archipelago. Accommodations are primarily B&Bs and family-run guesthouses, offering genuine and informal hospitality. The welcome is characterized by a strong sense of community and attentiveness to guests.

EXPERIENCES THAT INSPIRE AND UNITE

Suðuroy offers MICE activities related to the rural and marine environment, with workshops on traditional fishing, sustainable agriculture, and local arts. Nature excursions, traditional cooking workshops, and meetings with artisans complete the experience, fostering moments of team building and shared reflection. Traditions and nature provide the backdrop to every experience.

FAROE ISLANDS: DEEP SILENCE, NORDIC ROOTS, AND A SHARED VISION

ITINERARY – INTEGRATED MICE

DAY 1 – TÓRSHAVN: NORDIC HOSPITALITY AND CLEAR THINKING

The journey begins in **Tórshavn**, Europe's smallest capital, yet brimming with identity. The group gathers in a minimalist design hotel overlooking the harbor, where the Atlantic's grazing light sculpts every detail. The kickoff takes place in a room with stone and dark wood walls: here, far from distractions, the work is carried out with clarity. After a Nordic aperitif with local gin and seasonal finger foods, dinner is served in a Michelin-starred restaurant: dishes that speak of the region, from the sea to the pasture, and spark profound conversations.

DAY 2 – SAKSUN AND GJÓGV: POETIC LANDSCAPES AND AUTHENTIC DIALOGUE

The group sets off for the north of the island: among hidden fjords, fairytale villages, and roads seemingly sculpted by the wind. In an old farmhouse in **Saksun**, transformed into a creative space, a co-design session takes place: small groups work on future visions, accompanied by the sound of sheep grazing in the distance and the scent of damp wood in the air. After a rustic lunch of local produce, they reach the village of **Gjógv**, overlooking a spectacular gorge. Here, in a room overlooking the ocean, discussions continue, inspired by the strength of resilient communities. The evening concludes with a bonfire and oral histories passed down by the locals: tradition and innovation meet.

DAY 3 – MYKINES: CREATIVE ISOLATION AND SILENT COHESION

The day begins with a boat ride to **Mykines**, a remote island inhabited almost exclusively by puffins and windswept birds. The group retreats to a small lodge for an immersive experience, free from digital distractions. A walk to the lighthouse provides an opportunity for informal discussions and free-flowing ideas. In the afternoon, a visioning workshop takes place in a circle, using natural materials and Nordic facilitation techniques. Dinner is simple but thoughtful, cooked together with local guests. In this essential setting, cohesion becomes authentic and reflection deepens.

DAY 4 – VÁGAR: GENTLE ADRENALINE AND REFRESHING VISIONS

Back in **Vágar**, the atmosphere changes. The morning is dedicated to outdoor activities: hiking to the famous lake suspended above the ocean, team-building sessions focused on trust and orientation in nature. A new energy, both physical and mental, fills the air. After an outdoor lunch with an endless view, we retreat to an elegant guesthouse for a workshop to share our thoughts, key words, and insights. Dinner is held in a former school converted into a convivial room, with live acoustic music: a lighthearted experience after the intensity.

DAY 5 – TÓRSHAVN: RITUAL CLOSING AND NEW BEGINNINGS

Back in **Tórshavn**, the group gathers for a final meeting in a small cultural center overlooking the fjord. Each participant shares a mental image, a lesson, a transformation. The journey doesn't end, it opens. The final brunch, with warm bread, artisanal jams, and filtered coffee, is a collective embrace. We toast to the future, knowing that our time in the Faroes has left something true and lasting: deep connections, an open mind, and a new perspective on what's possible.

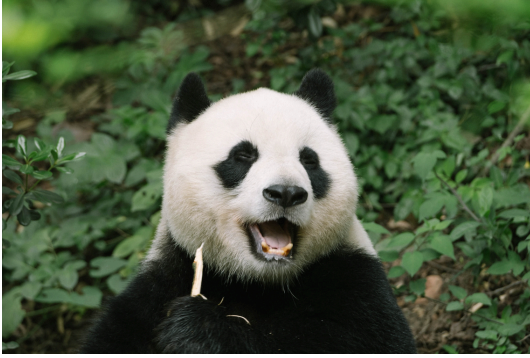

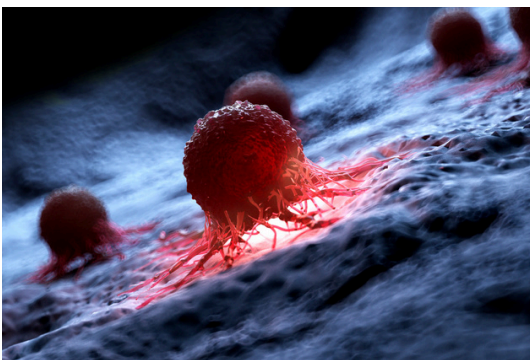
