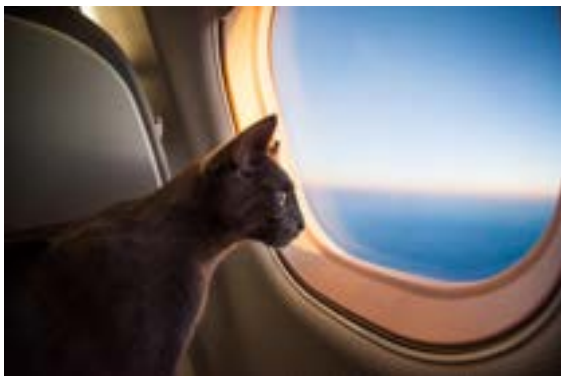

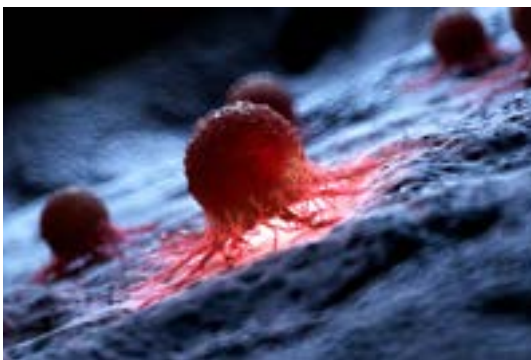

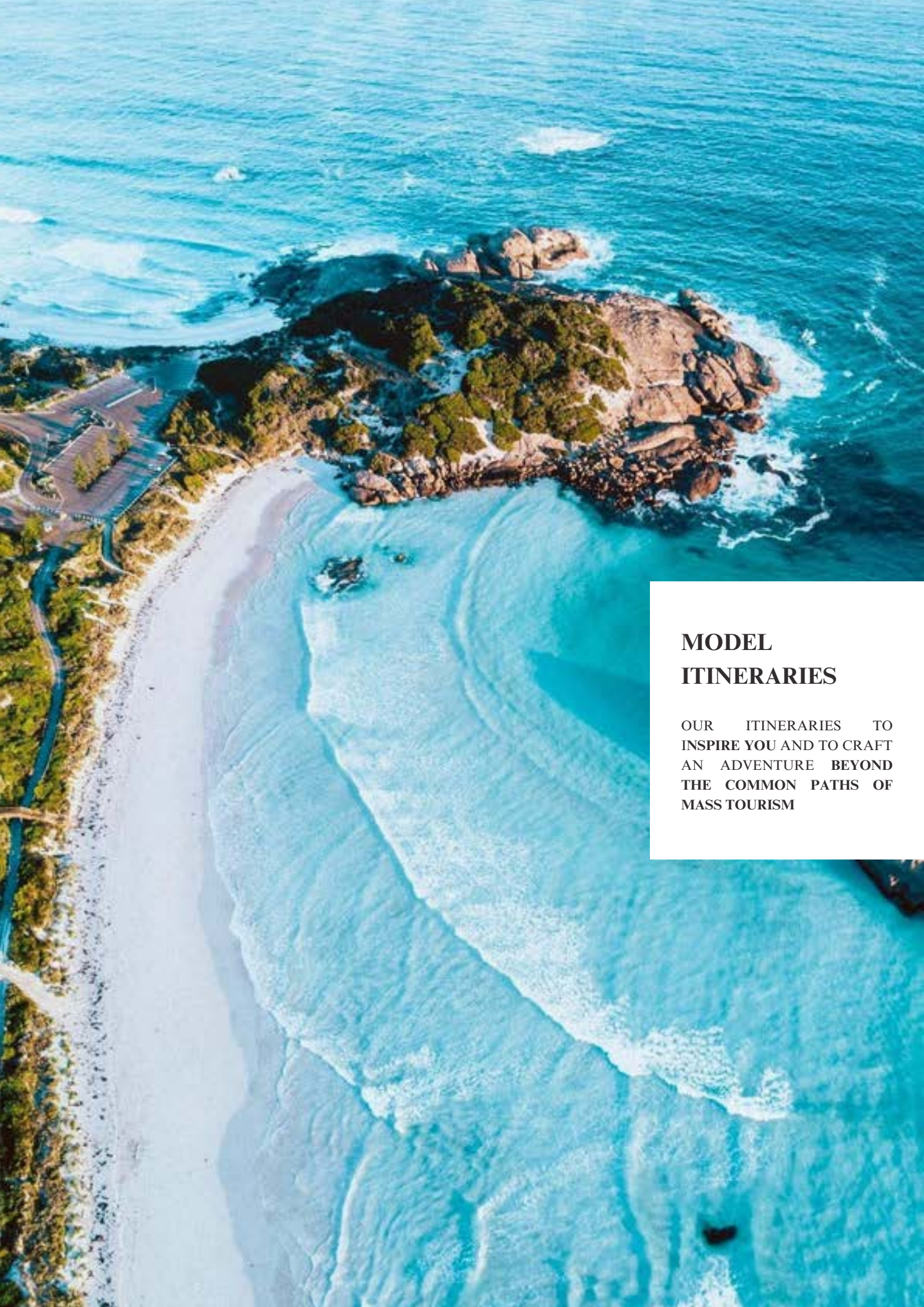

BETWEEN PRIMORDIAL OCEANS, REMOTE ISLANDS AND COASTS INHABITED BY SILENCE

Sailing in Australia means exploring a marine continent where the vastness of the ocean meets the intimacy of the most remote bays, where Aboriginal routes intertwine with modern ones, and the landscape changes radically from coast to coast. With over 25,000 km of coastline and thousands of islands, Australia is a terrestrial archipelago surrounded by seas that tell stories of evolution, isolation, and natural wonder. From the Great Barrier Reef to the Kimberley Islands, from the temperate coasts of the south to the wild expanses of the Indian Ocean, each landfall reveals a unique geography, often inaccessible by land.

Choosing a sailboat, catamaran, motoryacht, or themed cruise in Australia means coming into direct contact with some of the richest and most protected marine environments in the world: multicolored reefs, deserted beaches, coastal forests, and coastal communities still living in profound dialogue with nature. The sea experience allows you to discover territories off the beaten track, navigating marine parks, Aboriginal cultural sites, and remote environments that preserve extraordinary biodiversity. In Australia, the sea is vast and detailed, silent and vibrant: a horizon that welcomes and surprises those who choose to be carried by the wind, the currents, and a still-dominant nature.





SAILING ALONG THE EAST COAST OF TASMANIA, AMONG WILD ISLANDS, DESERTED BAYS AND UNSPOILED NATURE

The itinerary begins from **Triabunna**, a small port on **Tasmania's** east coast, with a ferry to **Maria Island**, a vehicle-free nature reserve where kangaroos, wallabies, and wombats roam freely among colonial ruins and eucalyptus forests. After a hike to the **Painted Cliffs**, the voyage continues to **Schouten Island**, a remote and uninhabited island ideal for snorkeling and kayaking amid turquoise waters and rocky seabeds. On the third day, we reach the **Freycinet Peninsula**, where **Wineglass Bay** welcomes the boat with its perfect curve of pure white sand. Here, you can hike up **Mount Amos** for spectacular views or explore the coast by tender.

The route continues to the mystical islands of **The Nuggets**, a little-known archipelago where gannets and albatrosses nest, and then to **Eddystone Point**, with its red lighthouse nestled among cliffs and bush. The next stop is the **Bay of Fires**, a coastal stretch of orange rocks and powdery sand, perfect for sunrise walks and dolphin watching. The last night is spent at anchor on **Flinders Island**, in the **Furneaux Islands**, amidst vast skies, deserted trails, and communities still living by the rhythms of the ocean. A voyage of deep navigation, in close contact with the wildest part of Tasmania, amid extraordinary biodiversity, silence, and pure beauty.





SAILING AMONG THE WILD ISLANDS OF THE KIMBERLEY, SEA WATERFALLS AND COASTS SCULPTED BY TIME

Departure from **Derby**, one of the world's highest tidal ports and a prime gateway to the Buccaneer Archipelago. After boarding, we'll sail past windswept granite islands and turquoise waters, with our first stop at **Talbot Bay**, famous for its **Horizontal Falls**, spectacular cascades caused by the extreme tidal range. We'll continue to **Crocodile Creek**, a secluded cove with freshwater pools where you can safely swim amidst the bush, followed by a night at anchor under sweeping skies.

The following days are dedicated to exploring the islands of **Cone Bay**, **Strickland Bay**, and **Yampi Sound**, home to wildlife sanctuaries, ancient Aboriginal rock art galleries accessible only by sea, and geological formations dating back over two billion years. The days are filled with dinghy excursions into flooded canyons, sustainable fishing, kayaking through mangroves, and close encounters with dolphins, turtles, and seabirds.

The route also includes **Koolan Island**, a former iron mine and now a nature reserve, and the final landing at **Cape Leveque**, with its red cliffs plunging into an emerald-green sea. Here, you can meet the **Bardi Jawi** community, who live according to traditional rhythms tied to the sea. The itinerary concludes with pure white sands, fiery sunsets, and the knowledge of having sailed to one of the most isolated and untouched corners of the Australian continent, where every day is a journey into pristine beauty.

PRE-CRUISE EXPERIENCE

Three nights in **Darwin** to gradually immerse yourself in the spirit of the tropical ocean and the journey that awaits. You'll stay among the night markets of **Mindil Beach**, **Litchfield National Park**, with its swimmable waterfalls and salt pans teeming with migratory birds. A day is dedicated to visiting the **Northern Territory Museum**, where you'll discover the history of Australian ocean exploration and the cultural connections with the Indian Ocean islands.

Those interested can attend a dinner concert with touring Cocos Island musicians, or a workshop on the dances of the Malay communities living on the islands. Darwin, with its location suspended between Asia and Oceania, prepares the eye for the concept of the archipelago as a world unto itself: a fascinating introduction to navigating forgotten lands.



REASONS TO GO

This cruise is for those who wish to venture beyond the coast and discover oceanic Australia, made up of far-flung overseas territories, unique ecosystems, and Creole cultures balanced between the East and the Pacific. **Christmas Island**, known as the "Galápagos of Australia," offers rainforests inhabited by millions of red crabs, sea caves, and vertical coral reefs plunging into the deep ocean. The **Cocos (Keeling) Islands**, meanwhile, welcome travelers with transparent lagoons, uninhabited sandy atolls, and a vibrant local Malay culture, preserved by a small community living in symbiosis with the sea.

On board, nature guides and marine biologists accompany each excursion with insightful explanations of the fragile balance of these islands, while experts in colonial and oceanic history illustrate the complex connections between naval routes and human history. Far from conventional cruises, this journey offers an immersion in a true island dimension, where every landing speaks to the strength of nature and the resilience of the communities that inhabit it. A navigation between the geographical and cultural boundaries of Australia, in the ocean that shaped it.

Three nights in **Cairns** to acclimatize to the tropical climate and immerse yourself in the local culture. Visit the Great Barrier Reef **Marine Park**, with snorkeling excursions and visits to coral reef research centers. The **Cairns Night Market** offers an authentic experience, featuring Aboriginal crafts and tropical cuisine. The second day is dedicated to an excursion into the **Daintree Rainforest**, one of the planet's oldest ecosystems, with guided walks and observations of endemic wildlife. This natural and cultural introduction prepares the traveler to face the week at sea with fresh eyes and an open heart. The third day offers a deep dive into local history and traditions, with visits to the Aboriginal villages of **Yarrabah** and **Wujal Wujal**, where you can participate in traditional art and music workshops. Discover ancient fishing techniques and savor local cuisine, gaining direct contact with the communities that have always lived in symbiosis with these lands. This preparatory time deepens your understanding and sensitivity to the landscapes and cultures you will encounter during the cruise.



REASONS TO GO

This cruise is designed for those who want to venture beyond conventional tourism and discover the wildest and most authentic side of the **Great Barrier Reef** and Northern Australia. **Cape York** is a remote land, rich in Aboriginal history, with landscapes ranging from mangroves and savannahs to deserted beaches lapped by crystal-clear seas. The Torres Strait Islands are a mosaic of unique cultures, where seafaring traditions and local myths intertwine with spectacular marine biodiversity.

Among the most evocative stops are **Thursday Island**, with its natural harbor and vibrant markets; **Horn Island**, famous for its military history and pristine beaches; and **Prince of Wales Island**, the beating heart of indigenous traditions. You'll also visit communities like **Bamaga**, which maintains a strong connection to the surrounding land and sea, offering authentic encounters with local culture.

On board, naturalists and anthropologists share their knowledge during excursions, deepening respect for the fragile ecosystems and indigenous communities that have protected these lands for millennia. This voyage is an invitation to discover the profound connection between humanity and nature in one of the most extraordinary and least explored corners of Australia, for an experience that will remain in your heart and memory.

FRENCH POLYNESIA

BETWEEN TURQUOISE LAGOONS, ANCESTRAL MYTHS AND VILLAGES SUSPENDED IN TIME

Sailing in French Polynesia means entering a world of paradise islands, where pristine nature and ancient cultures coexist in a rare balance. With over 100 islands and atolls spread across a vast territory in the heart of the Pacific, this archipelago offers spectacular scenery with crystalline lagoons, vibrant coral reefs, and volcanic mountains reflected in the calm sea. From the Society Islands, such as Tahiti and Bora Bora, to the more remote Tuamotu and Gambier atolls, every stop is an immersion in Polynesian tradition and natural harmony, where time seems to flow at a slower, more profound pace. Sailing here means embracing a culture steeped in myths, songs, dances, and legends, encountering authentic communities and extraordinary landscapes, far from conventional tourist routes.

The clear waters invite diving and snorkeling among colorful fish, unique corals, and hidden shipwrecks. Far from mass tourism, you can discover traditions rooted in centuries of history, including ancient ceremonies and local crafts that tell stories of people and the sea. Here, each island is a microcosm of biodiversity and culture, an invitation to a journey that nourishes body and soul in equal measure.

One cannot talk about Polynesia without mentioning Paul Gauguin, the French painter who lived in Tahiti and the Marquesas Islands, where he found inspiration for some of his most famous works. His stay in these lands speaks of an encounter between art and wild nature, between the search for a lost paradise and the primordial beauty of the islands, still perceptible today in the vibrant colors and scenery that enchant every navigator.

A boat trip from **Tahiti** to the **Marquesas Islands (Hiva Oa, Nuku Hiva, Ua Pou)** with stops dedicated to exploring places associated with **Paul Gauguin**: his house-museum in **Atuona (Hiva Oa)**, the sites that inspired his works, and the cemetery where he is buried alongside Jacques Brel, another great lover of these islands. In addition to Gauguin, the itinerary includes excursions to traditional villages, trekking through the volcanic landscapes and rainforests of **Nuku Hiva**, visits to archaeological sites such as the giant tikis of **Hatiheu**, and diving in waters rich in marine life near **Ua Pou** and **Tahuata**. Stops can be added on to **Fatu Hiva**, the southernmost island of the Marquesas, known for its breathtaking cliffs, secluded beaches, and local artisan communities who still practice traditional weaving and sculpture. During the voyage, savor local cuisine prepared with fresh island produce and participate in encounters with the locals to learn about ancestral Polynesian dances and songs. This boat trip combines art, culture and wild nature far from the mass tourist circuits, offering an immersive and intimate experience with the authentic heart of Polynesia.

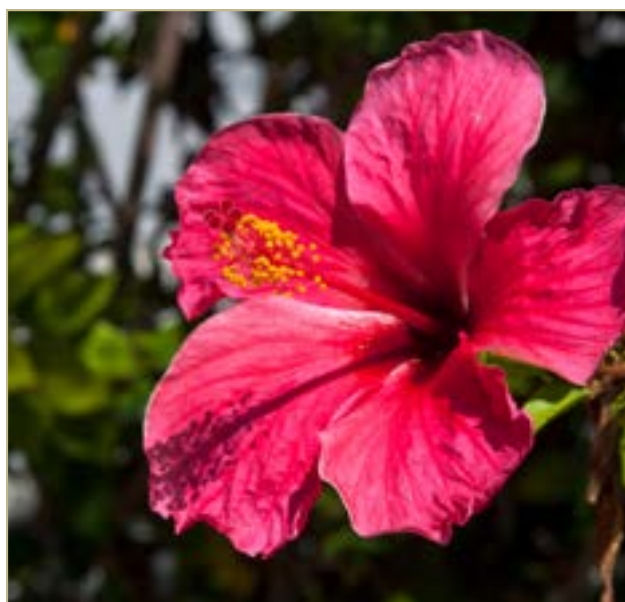

PRE-CRUISE EXPERIENCE

Three nights in **Anaa**, one of the lesser-known atolls of the **Tuamotu**, inhabited by just 500 people and boasting an intact marine and cultural landscape. Stay in family-run guesthouses run by the local community, nestled among coconut palms, coral beaches, and inland lagoons that glow pink at sunset. Days begin with shell collecting and snorkeling among ancient corals and quiet passages, and continue with visits to artisanal workshops where mother-of-pearl and pandanus are crafted. The second day is dedicated to meetings with local masters who share ocean legends, traditional dances, and songs. On the third day, we reach **Hao** to witness daily life on an atoll almost forgotten by tourism: fishing villages, converted former military bases, and resilient communities that tell another side of Polynesia. A time for listening, slowing down, and authentic cultural immersion.



REASONS TO GO

This cruise is designed for those who wish to explore the most secret Polynesia, beyond the postcard images, on an itinerary that prioritizes the essential, the remote, and the authentic. Sailing from **Hao** to **Amanu**, then **Mangareva** and the smaller islands of the **Gambier**, you'll encounter ancient volcanic stone churches built by 19th-century missionaries, family-run pearl mills, and villages that still live to the rhythms of the ocean. On board, local guides, ethnographers, and naturalists share the history of these little-known islands, guardians of a unique spirituality and fragile biodiversity. The deep, transparent waters are home to endemic species, while the islands offer dramatic views of mountains and lagoons. It's a journey that teaches you to unlearn the superfluous, to listen to the wind, and to rediscover the meaning of travel as a journey of encounter and respect. Far from any conventional tourist route, this experience represents a rare opportunity to connect with the most silent and spiritual heart of the Pacific Ocean.
