BETWEEN ATLANTIC CURRENTS, DISCREET ELEGANCE AND ARCHIPELAGOS SUSPENDED IN TIME


Bermuda isn't just a remote corner of the Atlantic: it's a crossroads of colonial memories, pastel architecture, sunken gardens, and traditions suspended between Europe and the Caribbean. Sailing along its rugged coastline means entering a world where every inlet tells of legendary shipwrecks, silent resistance, and a culture that has reinvented itself amidst coral reefs and ocean swarms.

The boats sail between secret atolls, pink beaches, and harbors that smell of mahogany and salt. The cruises chart routes off the beaten track of fast-paced tourism, allowing for profound experiences, authentic encounters with local communities, and immersion in the fragile nature of an archipelago that daily grapples with the balance between beauty and climate change.

Every bay invites discovery: Hamilton with its contrasts between colonial history and contemporary vibrancy, St. George's as a cradle of maritime tales and urban resistance, the southwestern coasts where the coral reef welcomes those who observe with respect. Here, the Atlantic is not just a backdrop, but a voice. And sailing between these islands becomes an intimate gesture of connection, listening, and wonder.











BERMUDA - BETWEEN SECRET BAYS, SEA CAVES AND SUBMERGED TRACES OF COLONIAL HISTORY

An itinerary designed to sail among **Bermuda**'s most fascinating yet less touristy islands, discovering an archipelago poised between colonial history, marine biodiversity, and island sophistication. The itinerary begins in **St. George**'s, an ancient port and UNESCO World Heritage Site, where cobbled streets and Georgian homes introduce the traveler to a rich past of sailing ships, migrations, and maritime tales. The voyage continues toward **Castle Harbour** and **Cooper's Island Nature Reserve**, a still little-known protected area, where you can alternate snorkeling among coral reefs, hiking along coastal paths, and spotting rare birds

The heart of the itinerary touches Mangrove Bay and Somerset Village, two hidden gems on the west coast, ideal for kayaking in the mangroves and encounters with local communities steeped in Anglo-Caribbean culture. South Shore Park and its secluded beaches, such as Jobson's Cove, offer moments of silence and contemplation, far from the tourist routes. The itinerary concludes with an exploration of the sea caves of Walsingham Nature Reserve and a dive among the sunken shipwrecks off the north coast, where naval history blends with marine life. A journey through Atlantic geography and colonial memories, it offers a new perspective on an archipelago at once refined and wild.

PRE-CRUISE EXPERIENCE

Three nights in the **Flatts Village** area, a quiet coastal village overlooking one of the island's most protected and peaceful bays. Stay in small, historic guesthouses overlooking the lagoon, immersed in a community that preserves the living memory of Anglo-Atlantic culture. Days alternate between visits to the marine aquarium and the karst caves of **Blue Hole Park**, kayaking along **Flatts Inlet**, and relaxing in the nearby botanical gardens. The experience is enriched by meetings with marine biologists and local custodians of the coastal landscape, who introduce the traveler to a profound understanding of the relationship between community and ocean. A slow, precious introduction that prepares the gaze and pace for the sea voyage that follows.



REASONS TO GO

The cruise follows a circular route through Bermuda's lesser-visited bays: from Hungry Bay, a mangrove reserve and biodiversity refuge, to Ely's Harbour and the pink cliffs of Whale Bay. Each stop offers access to natural and historical microcosms, such as the sunken shipwrecks in the Western Blue Cut area and the ancient British fortifications of Paget Island. The onboard experience is enriched by meetings with local experts and activities dedicated to naval archaeology, coral reef conservation, and the archipelago's nautical tradition. This cruise is designed for those who wish to experience the sea in a profound and mindful way, slowly navigating history, ecology, and refined ocean solitude.

GREENLAND

BETWEEN SCULPTED ICE, DEEP SILENCES AND ARCTIC RESILIENCE

Greenland is more than just the world's largest island: it's an interior continent, a landscape of light and ice where life pulsates silently yet tenaciously. Sailing along its jagged coastline means entering a world where time slows, glaciers tell age-old stories, and Inuit communities transform adaptation into an everyday art. Ships ply deep fjords, wind-sculpted icebergs, and villages that seem to float between land and sea. Cruises follow less traveled routes, avoiding major commercial routes and favoring remote landings where the encounter with nature and local culture becomes profound and transformative. Every stretch of coast tells a story: Ilulissat with its living glacier and the songs emerging from the ice blocks, Qaqortoq between urban art and Danish colonial memory, the villages of the South where Arctic tradition coexists with experiences of sustainability and self-production. Here the ocean is a living surface, changing with the light and climate, and sailing means learning to read the landscape with humility and attention.









GREENLAND - AMONG MAJESTIC FJORDS, INUIT VILLAGES, AND ANCIENT GEOLOGICAL MEMORIES

Far from the cruise ship routes, this private boat itinerary explores **Greenland**'s west coast, amidst deep fjords, Inuit villages, and utter silence. It departs from **Nuuk**, a vibrant and surprising capital city, where contemporary art and ancient Arctic legends coexist in museums and colorful streets. From there, you'll sail along the **Kapisillit Fjord** to the remote **Qooqqut** inlet, where you can savor freshly caught seafood in local restaurants accessible only by sea.

We continue towards the village of **Qeqertarsuatsiaat**, nestled between mountains and waters rich in wildlife: whales, seals, and sea eagles accompany the voyage along this still largely unexplored stretch of coast. The stop in **Paamiut Fjord**, amid floating icebergs and basalt cliffs, is an invitation to contemplate and discover the island's ancient geology. The itinerary concludes in **Maniitsoq Bay**, known as "the Venice of Greenland" for its maze of islets and natural channels: a place of archaic beauty and authentic encounters. Seven days of silent and powerful navigation, where every landscape is a story carved in ice and rock, and every village a point of contact between an ancestral past and a resilient future.

PRE-CRUISE EXPERIENCE

Three nights in **Ilulissat**, a village overlooking the country's most famous ice fjord and a UNESCO World Heritage site. Stay in eco-friendly lodges overlooking the shifting glaciers, listening to the sound of ice floes breaking off and floating in the fjord. Days alternate between hiking with local Inuit guides, visits to the **Climate Change Center**, and moments of sharing with communities balancing tradition and adaptation. An intense introduction to the heart of Greenland, where the encounter with the landscape is also an encounter with the planet's deep time.



REASONS TO GO

The cruise follows a northwestern route, departing from **Ilulissat** and visiting coastal villages such as **Oqaatsut**, **Saqqaq**, and **Qeqertaq**, connected only by sea. Each stop reveals a different Greenland: here, Inuit culture is still central, the rhythm of nature dictates the days, and the welcome is intimate and authentic. The landscapes alternate between ice-carved fjords, volcanic cliffs, and silent bays. On board, we organize in-depth discussions with experts on Arctic climate and culture, landscape photography activities, and Nordic cuisine featuring local products. A profound and mindful experience for those who wish to explore the Earth's extreme beauty with respect and wonder.

FAROE ISLANDS


BETWEEN MAJESTIC CLIFFS, LIVELY FOLKLORE AND SEAS THAT TELL ANCIENT STORIES

The Faroe Islands are more than just a remote archipelago in the North Atlantic: they are a mosaic of resilient communities, wild landscapes, and traditions intertwined with the rhythms of the sea and sky. Sailing among these islands means immersing yourself in a universe where nature reigns supreme, with spectacular cliffs, secluded coves, and a centuries-old cultural heritage.

The boats ply the often shifting waters, passing villages of colorful houses, windswept pastures, and trails that climb to mountaintops. The cruises favor less frequented landings, allowing for intimate and profound experiences with local communities and the discovery of a landscape as powerful as it is fragile.

Each island tells a different story: Tórshavn, the vibrant capital and guardian of a changing culture; Mykines with its puffin colonies and untamed nature; Vágar, where Lake Sørvágsvatn defies gravity as it plunges into the sea. Here, the sea is not just a border, but a bond. Sailing among the Faroes thus becomes a journey of discovery, listening, and genuine wonder.

Sailing the **Faroe Islands** means following ancient and silent routes, where every bay tells a legend and every cliff seems sculpted by the wind. This itinerary begins in **Tórshavn**, Europe's smallest capital, where you can experience a fascinating mix of Viking history and contemporary life. From there, we set sail for the island of **Sandoy**, past grassy villages, basalt formations, and local myths still alive in the collective memory. The journey continues to **Skúvoy**, a land of seabirds and ancient tales, ideal for cliff-top walks and birdwatching in complete silence.

A thrilling stop is **Koltur**, a now almost uninhabited island where time seems suspended: here, the grass-roofed houses and agricultural ruins speak of a civilization in symbiosis with the landscape. Next, the small port of **Gjógv** on the island of **Eysturoy**, with its natural fjord and musical traditions, offers one of the archipelago's most iconic views. The itinerary concludes between the wild bays of **Kalsoy** and the cliffs of **Viðoy**, where you sail among sea stacks and sea caves, spotting puffins, seals, and dolphins. Seven days of sailing in a world straight out of a Nordic fairytale, where nature reigns supreme and the local hospitality is sincere and discreet.

PRE-CRUISE EXPERIENCE

Three nights in **Kirkjubøur**, the most important historic village in the Faroes, overlooking the Atlantic and continuously inhabited for over 900 years. Stay in traditional guesthouses with grass roofs, surrounded by medieval ruins, black timber houses, and grazing sheep. Days are divided between scenic coastal walks, tastings of Faroese cuisine (including smoked lamb and fermented fish), and workshops with local artisans. The village offers an ideal introduction to the culture of the islands, where myth, faith, and self-sufficiency blend in a daily life deeply connected to the landscape.



REASONS TO GO

This cruise skirts the archipelago's less accessible islands: departing from **Tórshavn**, it reaches **Fugloy** and **Svínoy**, among the most remote and authentic, with their vertiginous trails and isolated communities. It continues to **Mykines**, famous for its puffin colonies and walks through meadows suspended above the sea. Each stop is an opportunity to meet fishermen, listen to centuries-old oral histories, and immerse yourself in landscapes of primal power. On board, meetings with island ecology experts, evening screenings of Faroese life, and nature photography sessions enhance the experience. The cruise continues toward the northern fjords, including Eyjafjörður and Húsavík, with stops for whale watching and encounters with coastal communities committed to enhancing their natural and cultural resources. On board, local experts enrich the experience with insights into the environment, volcanoes, and Arctic life. Days at sea alternate naturalistic explorations with moments of reflection and listening, along with cultural activities that encourage a deeper understanding of the region.
