# NORTHERN MALTA - MELLIEĦA, ST. PAUL'S BAY, MGARR, NAXXAR, MOSTA

#### BETWEEN OPEN SEAS, RURAL ARCHAEOLOGY AND REGENERATING NATURE

Northern Malta is a land of light and space, where sandy beaches, rolling hills, and authentic villages coexist with prehistoric sites and breathtaking views. This is where the island's most iconic bays—such as Golden Bay and Għadira—lie alongside megalithic temples and 16th-century watchtowers. ## SOUTHERN MALTA - MARSAXLOKK, ŻEJTUN, ŻABBAR, FGURA

#### BETWEEN HISTORIC PORTS, LIVING CULTURE AND LOCAL AUTHENTICITY

The south is Malta's historic and popular heart, where maritime roots and religious traditions coexist with a vibrant and participatory culture. The Three Cities—Birgu, Senglea, and Cospicua—retain the imprint of the Knights of Malta, while villages like Marsaxlokk speak of a deep connection to the sea. It is an authentic region, perfect for cultural events, experiences of social cohesion, and storytelling activities linked to intangible heritage.

#### ACCESSIBILITY AND HOSPITALITY

Easily accessible from Valletta, the south offers intimate yet characterful accommodations: historic guesthouses, local museums, private courtyards, community halls, and outdoor spaces. Local operators are highly engaged and open to collaboration with cultural and institutional organizations.

#### EXPERIENCES THAT INSPIRE AND UNITE

Among the options: storytelling workshops in the villages, guided tours of historic forts and shipyards, culinary experiences with local families, and workshops among the traditional boats in the harbor. ### MINOR ISLANDS - GOZO AND COMINO

# BETWEEN SLOW RHYTHMS, MEDITERRANEAN SPIRITUALITY AND SYMBOLIC NATURE

Gozo and Comino are Malta's contemplative face: islands where time slows, the light changes hourly, and presence deepens. Gozo, with its agricultural landscapes, Neolithic temples, and intimate communities, is a perfect destination for creative retreats and small groups seeking inspiration. Comino, with its Blue Lagoon, is a rarefied, marine space, ideal for symbolic and regenerating experiences.

#### ACCESSIBILITY AND HOSPITALITY

Accessible by ferry from Cirkewwa or by private boat, Gozo and Comino offer a discreet and attentive welcome. Gozo features agritourism, stone guesthouses, and small creative hubs. Comino lacks complex tourist infrastructure, but is charming for brief, symbolic experiences.

#### EXPERIENCES THAT INSPIRE AND UNITE

Writing sessions in stone villages, symbolic excursions to Ġgantija or Dwejra, bonding activities among olive groves and vineyards, days of reflection in pristine nature. The smaller islands are perfect for training retreats, interdisciplinary workshops, and group projects with a strong inner focus.

- Spring (March–May): Artistic residencies, group retreats, contemplative journeys.
- Summer (June–August): Outdoor experiences, symbolic immersions, creative micro-events.
- Autumn (September–November): Community trips, interdisciplinary workshops, experimental projects.
- Winter (December-February): Indoor sessions, slow reflections, writing and storytelling.



## ITINERARY - INTEGRATED MICE

#### DAY 1 - VALLETTA: THE LIMESTONE ELEGANCE OF THE CAPITAL

The arrival is bathed in the golden light of the walls of Valletta, a vibrant and refined capital city, perfect for a start. After checking into a boutique hotel with a rooftop sea view, the group meets in a conference room overlooking the harbor, featuring pale stone and impeccable technology. The afternoon is dedicated to a private walking tour of the bastions, secret staircases, hanging gardens, and contemporary art shops. At sunset, a networking cocktail aboard a yacht docked in the **Grand Harbour Marin**a is followed by a creative dinner in a former convent transformed into a design restaurant.

#### DAY 2 - MDINA AND THE SILENCE THAT SPEAKS: STRATEGIC RETREATS IN THE SILENT CITY

After a leisurely breakfast, we depart for **Mdina**, the ancient walled capital. The silent city, with its timeless streets, hosts the team for a high-impact strategic work session in a historic residence converted into an events center. Here, amid centuries-old walls and hidden terraces, concentration and vision reign supreme. Lunch is served in a stately palazzo overlooking the countryside of Malta. In the afternoon, team coaching with local occupational psychologists takes place in an olive grove in **Rabat**. We return to **Valletta** for a free evening in the city center's creative wine bars.

#### DAY 3 - GOZO: THE OTHER ISLAND, BETWEEN ARCHES, RITUALS, AND RURAL INNOVATION

An early wake-up call and ferry transfer to Gozo, the greener and more authentic sister island. The group is welcomed by local staff and taken to an ancient farmhouse for a day immersed in nature and culture. In the morning, a collaborative workshop takes place at a regenerative farm, followed by a light, locally sourced lunch. The afternoon is dedicated to a team hike through salt pans, megalithic temples, and rugged coastlines. A highlight? A sunset aperitif among the cliffs of the Inland Sea. A convival dinner with folk music in a private vineyard.

#### DAY 4 - BLUE GROTTO AND MARSAXLOKK: WATER RITUALS AND RELATIONSHIPS

Back in Malta, we set off for the south of the island. The morning begins with a relaxing stroll and gentle team building among the crystal-clear waters of the Blue Grotto, including a private boat excursion. After a light brunch by the sea, the group moves to Marsaxlokk, a still authentic fishing village. Here, an experiential workshop on leadership and adaptability takes place, focusing on traditional fishing and teamwork. The day concludes with a slow dinner in a renovated lighthouse, entirely reserved for the occasion.

#### DAY 5 - URBAN REBIRTH AND FUTURE VISION IN BIRKIRKARA

The final day is dedicated to vision. The group meets in **Birkirkara**, an emerging hub of Malta's new creative scene, where they meet local startuppers, designers, and changemakers for a roundtable discussion on sustainability and innovation in the Mediterranean. After brunch, the group moves on to an informal closing talk in a limestone quarry transformed into an art space. Between sculptures, installations, and moments of sharing, the journey concludes with renewed inspiration. Transfer to the airport in the late afternoon.

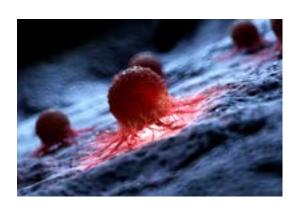
