SPAIN

BETWEEN REBELLIOUS COASTS, SECRET ARCHIPELAGOS AND SAILING CULTURES

Spain seen from the sea is a geography of contrasts: from the rugged Galician coast to the arid headlands of Andalusia, to the forgotten Balearic Islands and the volcanic landscapes of the Canary Islands. Here, sailing is not just a scenic delight, but also a deep immersion in coastal cultures that endure, reinvent themselves, and preserve ancient ties to the ocean and the wind.

Far from crowded beaches and the most touristy routes, marine trails open up connecting fishing villages, nature reserves, coves accessible only by sea, and islands where traditions intertwine with new ecological and community practices. Boats ply waters once traversed by sailors, poets, and smugglers, while cultural cruises sail along the eastern, Basque, and Canary Islands coasts, offering unexpected landings and authentic encounters.

Every port tells a language, a story, a rhythm. Every island holds a voice, between dry paths and seabeds teeming with life. Sailing Spain means entering into a relationship with a country that has always engaged with the sea: sometimes out of challenge, sometimes out of love, always out of necessity.









CANARY ISLANDS - AMONG HIDDEN COVES, VOLCANOES AND AUTHENTIC VILLAGES

Sailing far from the tourist routes, this itinerary winds through islands where wild nature and small villages preserve ancient stories and breathtaking landscapes. We begin in Tenerife with a stop in the less frequented coves of the south coast, continuing towards La Gomera, where laurisilva forests and hidden paths offer immersive walks and authentic contact with local communities. Continuing towards El Hierro, the most remote island, we explore protected marine reserves perfect for snorkeling and diving, and discover ancestral traditions still alive in fishing villages. La Palma is also worth a visit, with its rugged coastline, volcanic caves, and secluded bays, ideal for kayaking and hiking along extinct craters and Canarian pine forests. Returning to Gran Canaria and Tenerife, we stop in less-traveled ports, immerse ourselves in local markets, sample local products, and relax on little-known beaches. Every day is an invitation to slow down and experience the sea and the islands with respect and curiosity. The crystal-clear waters invite you to dive in secret spots, while small coves offer refuge from mass tourism. Guided excursions are also available to discover the islands' endemic fauna and unique flora, making each stop a complete and rejuvenating experience for those who love the sea and nature.

PRE-CRUISE EXPERIENCE

The departure begins with three nights in **Cudillero**, a picturesque fishing village nestled between towering cliffs and the deep sea. Here, you'll stay in traditional homes, soaking up the authentic atmosphere of a village far from the beaten tourist track. Days are dedicated to walks along scenic trails that reveal ancient legends, visits to markets where local producers meet, and participation in traditional Asturian cooking workshops, with the ever-present scent of the sea. In the evenings, live music accompanies encounters with fishermen and storytellers of the sea, preparing the soul and senses for an immersive and slow journey. A richly evocative introduction that opens the door to a sailing itinerary through still wild and little-explored territories.



REASONS TO GO

This cruise invites you to explore a lesser-known and authentic Spain, made up of wild landscapes and untouched coastlines, where time slows and nature reigns supreme. Among secluded bays like Praia do Trece, majestic lighthouses like Cabo Vilán, and deserted beaches that line the coast of Muxía, you'll encounter authentic fishing villages like Malpica and Camariñas, as well as protected nature reserves like the Atlantic Islands National Park. Guided excursions reveal traces of Celtic and Roman civilizations, with archaeological sites to discover near Fisterra. On board, local experts offer insights into marine history and biology, while docking in unfrequented ports allows for direct contact with resilient and hospitable communities. This journey combines powerful nature, historical memory, and the magic of a little-known sea, for those who wish to experience something off the beaten path with respect and wonder. Here, every landing is a moment of authentic connection, where past and present intertwine to tell stories of resistance and rebirth. The Costa da Morte, with its rugged landscapes and the power of the ocean, prompts profound reflection on the relationship between humanity and nature, while Galicia's smaller islands, such as Ons Island and picturesque Sálvora, surprise with their biodiversity and vibrant traditions. It's an invitation to rediscover a sea rich in secrets, where every wave tells a story and every stop turns into a discovery.

PORTUGAL

BETWEEN THE DEEP OCEAN, DISTANT ARCHIPELAGOS AND COASTS SCULPTED BY TIME

Portugal is a nation that looks to the ocean as an ancient home, a shifting border, and a promise of horizons. Navigating its rugged coastline, from the cliffs of the Alentejo to the hidden bays of the Algarve, means traversing centuries of Atlantic routes, stories of exploration and migration, but also communities that inhabit the sea with discretion and ancient knowledge.

And then there are the islands: Madeira, a land suspended between lush forests and rural traditions, and the Azores, nine volcanic worlds scattered across the vast blue, where sailing becomes meditation and adventure. The boats and cruises that traverse these lands follow silent trajectories, stopping at secondary ports, marine reserves, coves accessible only by sea, and villages that tell the story of a timeless Portugal.

Every route is an encounter: with living geology, with the whales that accompany the voyage, with the communities that preserve the music, food, and gestures of a living Atlantis. Sailing along and around Portugal is entering a universe that resists speed, where travel is still about listening, slowness, and a profound connection between man and the sea.











MADEIRA – BETWEEN WILD NATURE, HIDDEN COVES AND AUTHENTIC TRADITIONS



Departing from Funchal, Madeira's capital, we set sail toward the small, unspoiled islands of Porto Santo, with their golden beaches and relaxed atmosphere, far from mass tourism. We continue to the islet of Desertas, a natural paradise reserved for protected wildlife, ideal for snorkeling and seabird watching. The voyage then moves on to Selvagens, a group of even more remote islets, where nature reigns supreme and the silence is broken only by the sound of the waves. These secluded bays offer hiking trails through lunar landscapes and cliffs overlooking the sea. Along the way, you can discover small fishing communities and local artisans, savoring traditional dishes and participating in cooking or weaving workshops. A journey that combines nature, culture, and moments of pure relaxation in exclusive settings, far from mass tourism and large marinas. Sailing in these waters allows you to immerse yourself in a dimension of peace and authenticity, while the days are colored with fiery sunsets and unparalleled starry skies, accompanied by the song of sea birds and the scent of the sea.





AZORES – BETWEEN VOLCANOES, SUBMERGED CRATERS AND HIDDEN COVES

Boarding takes place in **Ponta Delgada (São Miguel)**, from where we sail to the lesser-visited and wild islands of **Flores** and **Corvo**, the two westernmost islands, rich in volcanic lakes, hidden waterfalls, and fairytale landscapes. We also dock at **Faial**, with its tranquil ports and the famous **Caldeira do Faial**, where you can explore volcanic trails and small, authentic villages. Stops are also available in the sheltered bays of **Terceira** and **São Jorge**, where you can dive in crystal-clear waters and visit unique geological formations such as the "fajas." During the voyage, we favor anchorages in secluded coves for hiking, kayaking, and birdwatching, far from conventional tourist routes. This itinerary offers a combination of breathtaking landscapes, authentic local traditions, and the chance to experience the archipelago from a unique perspective, immersed in the intense greenery and deep blue of the Atlantic. Days pass amid the gentle lapping of the waves and the fresh ocean air, while nights offer clear skies for observing constellations and the slow motion of the stars. Each stop is an invitation to delve deeper into the history and culture of the Azores through encounters with locals and tastings of typical products.







WESTERN PORTUGAL AND THE ATLANTIC ISLANDS - WEEKLY CRUISE THROUGH ALENTEJO, ALGARVE, AND LESSER-KNOWN ISLANDS

PRE-CRUISE EXPERIENCE

Three nights in Évora, a charming city in the Alentejo region and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, immerse you in an atmosphere suspended between past and present. Here, time passes slowly amidst cobbled streets, Romanesque architecture, and the remains of ancient temples. The stay includes personalized guided tours of lesser-known monuments, sunset strolls through historic neighborhoods, and artisanal workshops dedicated to ceramics and cork processing. Evenings are punctuated by fado concerts in small, traditional venues and local wine tastings in the surrounding rural wineries, far from the tourist circuit. A day is dedicated to exploring the rural villages of the deep Alentejo, among golden hills and windmills, to meet farmers and artisans who still pass on ancient knowledge. This pre-cruise experience allows for authentic connection with the deepest and most genuine side of Portugal, preparing the traveler for a slow, mindful, and meaningful voyage.



REASONS TO GO

Departing from the port of Lisbon, the cruise heads south, passing the bays and secluded villages of the Algarve and coastal Alentejo, stopping at ports like Sines and Vila Nova de Milfontes. Explore coastal nature reserves and small fishing communities, taking part in kayaking excursions, birdwatching, and visiting lesser-known archaeological sites. The route then heads toward the Madeira archipelago, stopping at islands like Porto Santo and the tiny Selvagem Grande, lesser-known than Funchal and the Desertas, offering trekking and diving in clear waters. Finally, the cruise reaches the Azores, stopping at islands like Santa Maria and Terceira, less crowded and rich in local history and wild nature. Onboard, environmental education programs and meetings with expert guides enrich the journey, which combines culture, nature, and relaxation far from mass tourism.

ITALY

BETWEEN SUSPENDED ISLANDS, FORGOTTEN COASTS AND NAVIGATIONS THAT REVEAL WORLDS

Italy, seen from the sea, reveals an intimate and fragmented face, made up of smaller islands, silent promontories, and coastlines where time passes more slowly. Sailing along the peninsula, from the Ligurian cliffs to the hidden coves of Calabria, from the red bays of Salento to the lagoons dotting the Adriatic coast, means rediscovering lands where the sea has always dictated the rhythm of daily and cultural life. Every stretch of coastline holds harbors that escape the routes of mass tourism, where communities still live in tune with the wind and the tide. And then there are the large islands: Sicily, with its volcanic offshoots-the Aeolian Islands, the Aegadian Islands, Pantelleria, Ustica—where the earth boils beneath the surface, and Sardinia, rugged and marine, with coastlines sculpted by the mistral wind, coves invisible from the mainland, and archipelagos that seem suspended in time. The Tuscan, Pontine, and Ligurian islands: each island fragment is a microcosm that speaks of identities, resistance, and geographies balanced between sea and land. Maritime routes take travelers away from crowded circuits, into small ports, wild coves, nature reserves, and villages that live the present without forgetting the past. Sailboats, catamarans, and cultural cruises become tools for exploring a different Italy: wilder, deeper, more authentic. Navigating Italy isn't just about traveling: it's about stopping, listening, immersing yourself. It's about rediscovering a cultural archipelago that extends far beyond geography.











AMONG SECRET ARCHIPELAGOS, SEASIDE VILLAGES AND THE PROTECTED SEA OF THE CENTRAL-SOUTHERN TYRRHENIAN SEA



Sailing offshore between southern Lazio, Campania, and Cilento, a fascinating itinerary unfolds, starting from Nettuno or Formia, first touching the wildest Pontine islands such as Palmarola and Santo Stefano, uninhabited jewels where nature reigns supreme. After a stop in Ponza, with its hidden coves and historic port, the journey continues toward Ventotene, amidst submerged archaeology and regenerated community gardens. After passing the Gulf of Gaeta, the journey continues along the Cilento coast, stopping at Marina di Camerota and Palinuro, amidst sea caves, coastal treks, and fishing communities guarding ancient knowledge. The journey ends between Sapri and Maratea, where the mountains plunge into the sea and the slow pace of life intertwines with village life. A week of authentic sailing amidst protected landscapes, gastronomic traditions, and still untouched routes, designed for those who wish to discover a more intimate and authentic side of the Italian Mediterranean. At some stops, you can join excursions with local nature guides, visit wineries overlooking the sea, or take part in small coastal festivals away from the tourist crowds. Three nights in **Matera**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site nestled between canyons and plateaus, introduce the journey with a deep immersion in the rock-cut history and cultural identity of Southern Italy. Stay in ancient dwellings carved into the rock, transformed into charming accommodations, and participate in guided tours of the Sassi and artisan workshops with local ceramic and papier-mâché masters. Days include visits to rock-cut mills, trekking on the **Murgia** plateau for botanical and archaeological observations, and moments of relaxation in the suspended silence of the ravine. Tastings in caves converted into wine cellars, folk theater performances, and sunset photo sessions are also included. Departure for the port of embarkation begins with a renewed perspective on a Southern Italy that endures and reinvents itself, ready to be rediscovered by the sea.



REASONS TO GO

This cruise unfolds along the southern Adriatic and the seas of Southern Italy, visiting some of Italy's lesser-known historic ports and most authentic smaller islands. From the architecture of Trani and Monopoli to the Art Nouveau villas of Santa Maria di Leuca, from the secret coves of the Tremiti Islands to the ancestral slowness of Alicudi and Filicudi, the journey is a continuous intertwining of landscapes and cultures. Stops at Ustica and Marettimo offer rare snorkeling experiences, underwater archaeological explorations, and contact with small communities of fishermen and artisans. Onboard expertsbiologists, historians, and photographers—enrich the narrative of the places, while the excursions venture off the beaten track: along unfrequented paths, through local markets, canning workshops, tuna fisheries, and village festivals. Each stop is an invitation to slow down and listen, to look at the Mediterranean with new eyes, rediscovering the profound meaning of travel as discovery, respect, and encounter.


