SEYCHELLES

BETWEEN GRANITE ISLANDS, MARINE RESERVES AND NAVIGATION IN THE HEART OF THE OCEAN

Sailing in the Seychelles is like entering a marine paradise where nature reigns supreme, shaping landscapes suspended between dream and reality. This Indian Ocean archipelago, made up of 115 islands including granite, coral, and remote atolls, creates a mosaic of turquoise bays, white beaches, and vivid seabeds. From the central islands of Mahé, Praslin, and La Digue, to the more remote Amirantes or Aldabra, each landing is an invitation to slow exploration, amidst pristine scenery and extraordinary biodiversity.

Far from crowded circuits and standardized routes, nautical tourism in the Seychelles offers a profound and sensory experience: catamarans, sailboats, and motoryachts allow you to live in harmony with the rhythm of the tides, exploring protected marine parks, fishing villages, and coastlines inaccessible by land. Cultural and nature cruises open windows onto a world of silence, views, and pristine nature, where every stop is a discovery.

In the Seychelles, the sea is the guardian of Creole stories, sunken shipwrecks, and centuries-old turtles. It's a journey through mangroves, coral reefs, and rocks shaped by time, where life flows slowly and poetically. Every voyage becomes a dialogue between man and the ocean, between land and wind, in one of the purest and most protected landscapes on the planet.











AMONG DISTANT ATOLLS, TROPICAL FORESTS AND RARE SANDS OF THE INDIAN OCEAN

Departing from the west coast of Mahé, the voyage immediately takes in the Sainte Anne Marine Reserve and the surrounding small islands, where you can swim among rays and giant tortoises. We continue towards Praslin, with a stop in the Vallée de Mai, a primeval forest and UNESCO site, home to the famous coco de mer. After anchoring at Anse Lazio for a swim in its iconic bay, the route leads to La Digue, a car-free island where you can cycle among pink granite beaches and timeless villages. The following days are dedicated to sailing to Curieuse and St. Pierre, havens for snorkeling and underwater photography, followed by a night at anchor between the smaller islands of Félicité and Coco. The journey concludes with the return to Mahé, passing through the secluded bays of the south, among coral reefs, guided dives, and dinners featuring freshly caught seafood. A slow, varied, and authentic sea experience, ideal for those seeking wild landscapes and hospitality designed by nature.



PRE-CRUISE EXPERIENCE

Three nights in **Mahé**, amidst Creole markets, tropical gardens, and jungle trekking. The stay begins in **Victoria**, one of the world's smallest capitals, where you'll visit the **Sir Selwyn Clarke Market**, the botanical gardens, and the national cultural center. This is followed by excursions into the **Morne Seychellois** mountains, along misty trails and overlooking the ocean. Also on the agenda are visits to small craft workshops, natural essence laboratories, and fishing villages on the west coast. The days pass by, bathing on secluded beaches, sampling Creole cuisine, and meeting local guides who specialize in endemic flora. This acclimatization period offers an authentic vision of the Seychelles, beyond the postcard images, and harmoniously introduces you to the archipelago's deeper dimension, made up of voices, rhythms, and memories. Every detail prepares you for sailing, a natural extension of the land experience.



REASONS TO GO

This cruise is designed for those who wish to sail through a still largely untouched archipelago, visiting smaller islands where tourism is minimal and nature reigns supreme. Stops include D'Arros, Desroches, Alphonse, and the Amirantes Islands, where you can spot migratory birds and manta rays and explore undisturbed coral reefs. The cruise includes indepth discussions with marine biologists, citizen science activities, visits to ecological stations, and encounters with local communities. Each stopover offers an opportunity to discover Creole cultures, fragile ecosystems, and stories linked to navigation and traditional fishing. It's an experience that combines contemplation and knowledge, ideal for those seeking a mindful way to travel, fully respecting the environment and host cultures. Sailing here means immersing yourself in a remote archipelago, where each island has its own rhythm and every day offers a different view of the


BETWEEN CORAL REEFS, VIRGIN ISLANDS AND CREOLE ROOTS ON THE WATER

Sailing in Mauritius means rediscovering an archipelago that extends beyond the main island, where the sea traces forgotten geographies, and sailing opens horizons of discovery amid colonial history, volcanic nature, and intersecting cultures. Beyond Mauritius itself, sister islands such as Rodrigues, Agalega, and Saint Brandon offer unusual itineraries for those who wish to get off the beaten track and experience the Indian Ocean through new eyes.

Sailboats, catamarans, and motoryachts allow you to explore protected areas, uninhabited islets, and secluded beaches, encountering fishing communities, pristine coral reefs, and ancient lighthouses. Nature and cultural cruises invite you to discover the diverse marine ecosystem as well as the cultural nuances of a country that blends Indian, African, French, and Chinese influences.

Sailing in Mauritius is an act of profound connection with the ocean, among fishermen who still use hand-dug dugout canoes, village markets, and bays where turtles nest. It's a journey into the diversity, slow pace, and wonder of an island that has preserved its liquid soul.











AMONG UNINHABITED ISLETS, MIXED CULTURES AND CRYSTALLINE LAGOONS BEYOND THE MAIN ISLAND

The itinerary begins from the **Grand Baie** marina on the north coast, where we set sail for **Coin de Mire** and **Flat Island**, small, wild islets ideal for snorkeling and seabird watching. After a night at anchor on **Gabriel Island**, famous for its pristine beaches and clear waters, we continue to **Île aux Serpents** and **Île Ronde**, protected areas of high ecological value. Over the following days, the route veers toward the east coast, stopping at **Poste Lafayette**, a relatively untouched area, and then **Île aux Cerfs**, to explore the inner lagoon by kayak and hike through the coastal forest. The voyage continues along the south coast to **Blue Bay**, where the seabed offers one of the country's most beautiful marine parks. The journey ends in **Mahébourg**, amidst local markets, small distilleries, and tales of pirates. It's an itinerary rich in natural and cultural diversity, perfect for those seeking the sea, authenticity, and true encounters with Mauritian culture away from the large resorts.

PRE-CRUISE EXPERIENCE

Three nights in **Mahébourg**, an ancient port village with a Creole soul. The stay begins with a visit to the **Naval Museum** and artisan markets, to understand the island's multi-ethnic history. You'll explore the surrounding nature reserves, such as **Pointe d'Esny** and **Ile aux Aigrettes**, with local eco-guides who will share their knowledge of endemic species conservation projects. Time passes between weaving workshops, live sega music, and Creole cuisine shared with local families. An excursion into the island's interior takes you to the Hindu temples of **Grand Bassin** and **Tamil** villages, relaxing on the sacred lake and walking trails scented with sugarcane. This stay on land introduces the traveler to the country's cultural and spiritual richness, preparing the eyes for a voyage to forgotten islands, where past and present intertwine.



REASONS TO GO

This cruise is designed for those who wish to explore beyond the main island, exploring the entire Mauritian archipelago. The routes include **Rodrigues**, with its slow agricultural rhythms and ravanne music; **Saint Brandon**, an exclusive nature reserve where the sea rules; and **Agalega**, a remote island with a timeless charm. On board, biologists, historians, and local guides offer encounters and narrations that enhance every stop. You'll explore fishing villages, witness traditional seaweed harvesting, and cook with the locals. The voyage alternates contemplative moments with marine activities, in one of the lesser-known areas of the Indian Ocean. It's an experience for those seeking cultural depth, a connection with nature, and a new way of experiencing the sea, far from the usual routes and postcard-perfect narratives.

ZANZIBAR

NAVIGATE THROUGH SPICES, SWAHILI CURRENTS, AND TIMELESS ISLANDS

Zanzibar is a gateway to the Indian Ocean, where sea routes intertwine with memories of the Spice Route and Swahili cultures. Sailing between these islands means discovering an archipelago steeped in history, scents, and encounters, made up of ancient currents and endless beaches. From the main island of Unguja to the more remote islands of Pemba and Mafia, passing through exposed sandbanks and mangrove forests, every sea voyage becomes a journey into the beating heart of coastal East Africa.

With traditional boats, modern catamarans, motor yachts, or sailing vessels, explore stretches of sea where tourism has yet to erase any traces of authenticity: villages on stilts, dhows that sail the horizon, fish markets at dawn, and deserted beaches beaten only by the wind. Cruises allow you to visit historic ports, marine reserves, and small atolls, with itineraries off the beaten track.

In Zanzibar, the sea is an oral narrative, a sailing culture that has united India, Africa, and Arabia for centuries. Every wave tells a story, every island holds a secret. Sailing here is like entering a poetic universe, made of profound silences, mingled accents, and landscapes that defy time.

We continue to **Bawe** and **Prison Island**, to encounter giant tortoises and visit old colonial buildings. After a sunset at anchor, the route turns north toward **Tumbatu** and **Kendwa**, with golden beaches and isolated villages accessible only by sea. In the following days, we explore **Mnemba** and **Nungwi Islands**, paradises for diving and dolphin watching. The journey concludes with a sail toward the east coast, among the lagoons of **Pongwe** and fishing villages, to experience daily life in Zanzibar. An itinerary that alternates protected seas, living traditions, and authentic encounters, in a corner of Africa vibrant with memories and light.

Three nights in **Stone Town**, the island's cultural heart and crossroads of civilizations. The stay includes guided tours of the historic neighborhoods, woodcarving workshops, and spice markets, where you can learn the secrets of Swahili cuisine. You'll take part in walking or cycling excursions to coastal villages, attend taarab music concerts, and explore ancient Arab houses overlooking the sea. During your stay, you'll connect with local artisans, scholars, and fishermen who offer a profound insight into Zanzibar's past and present. Each experience prepares you for a voyage of discovery, amidst vibrant culture, Muslim spirituality, and the intertwined languages that testify to the island's long maritime history.



REASONS TO GO

This cruise is designed for those who want to discover the hidden soul of the Zanzibar archipelago and its sister islands. We sail towards **Pemba**, through mangrove forests and communities living according to ancestral rhythms, and towards **Mafia Island**, famous for its marine reserves, deserted sandbanks, and humpback whales. Each stop offers a unique experience: coastal markets, coral mosques, mud and straw villages, schools overlooking the sea. On board, meetings with anthropologists, fishermen, and nature guides enrich the crossing. It is a journey that combines history and environment, culture and nature, in one of the Indian Ocean's least affected by mass tourism. 


ARCHIPELAGO OF LIGHT, CORAL REEFS AND SILENCE

Sailboats, catamarans, and motoryachts offer privileged access to delicate and protected ecosystems, from diving in the channels between atolls to stops on fish-rich islands, where Dhivehi culture is expressed among coral mosques and fireside tales. Cultural and nature cruises offer off-the-beaten-track itineraries, far from iconic sites, to truly experience the Maldives' marine and island identity.

Here, the sea isn't just a postcard backdrop, but a living and sacred presence, marking daily life and teaching us the measure of time. Sailing in the Maldives means following the monsoon currents, exploring the fragility of natural beauty, and rediscovering a subtle balance between adventure and contemplation, between silence and wonder.

Setting sail from Malé, the journey immediately takes a less traveled direction, sailing towards Felidhoo Atoll, where small villages welcome guests with a slow pace. We continue towards Meemu and Thaa, atolls that are less touristy but rich in marine life, with stops in crystalline lagoons, diving on pristine reefs, and lunches on board featuring the day's catch. The days follow the rhythm of the sun and the tides: we anchor in front of uninhabited islands, explore deserted beaches, and sleep at anchor under star-studded skies. The itinerary also visits villages like Kolhufushi and Dhiyamigili, where Dhivehi traditions are still intact and hospitality is genuine. The journey ends in Laamu Atoll, with its perfect waves for surfing, coconut groves, and lively fish markets. An experience that captures the true face of the Maldives, far from the resorts, amidst silence, nature, and community.
