# MAIN DESTINATIONS

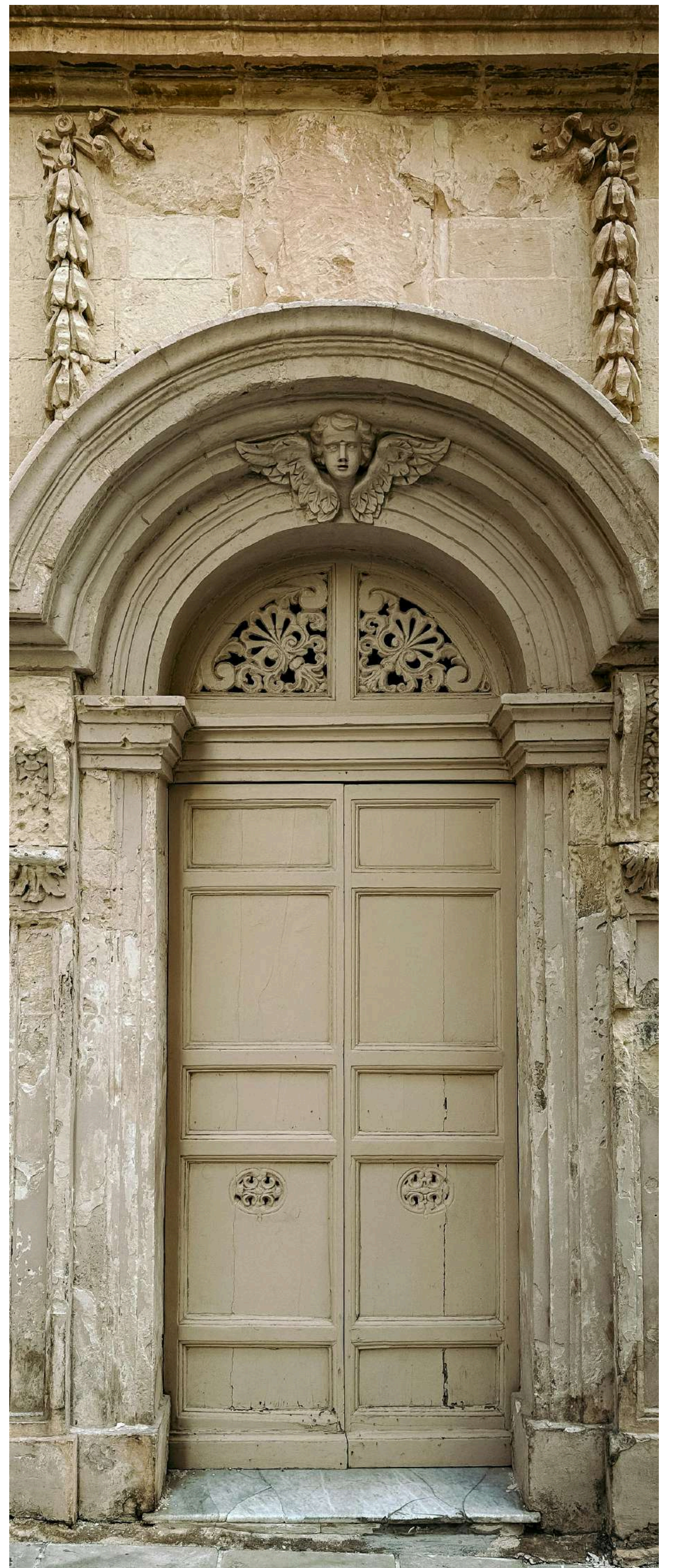
The main locations for studying English in Malta include Sliema, St. Julian's, and Valletta.

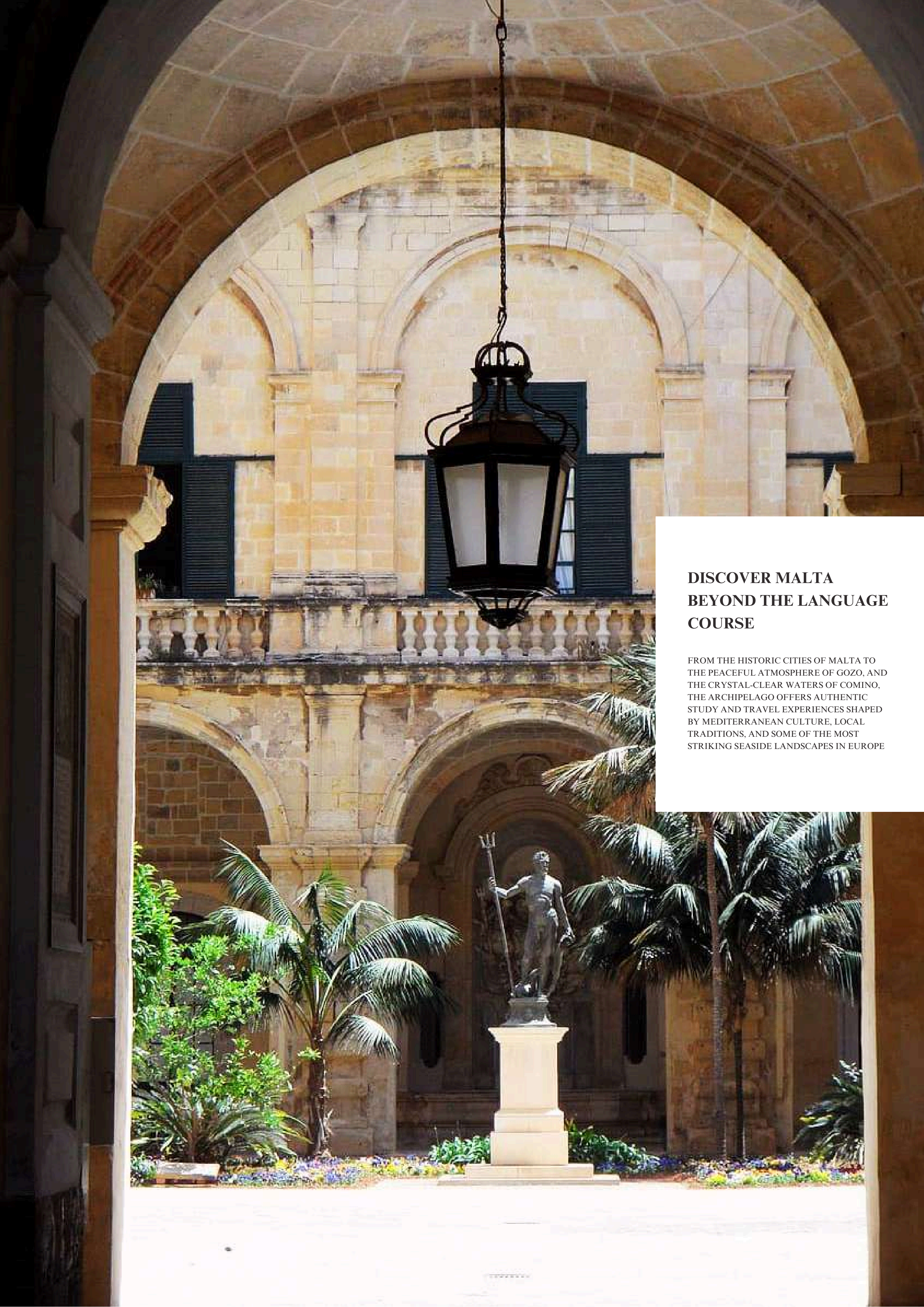

# MALTA - BETWEEN THE CENTRAL MEDITERRANEAN, HISTORICAL STRATIFICATION, AND AN INTEGRATED ISLAND SYSTEM



Situated in the central Mediterranean Sea, south of Sicily and along the main historical routes between Europe, North Africa, and the Middle East, Malta is one of the most compact yet stratified island systems in the Mediterranean. Primarily, the territory is composed of a small archipelago in which the three main islands—Malta, Gozo, and Comino—form a single geographical and functional system, characterized by rocky coastlines, natural inlets, and limestone plateaus. Geographically, the archipelago is primarily composed of the island of Malta, which is home to the majority of the population and infrastructure, the more rural and hilly island of Gozo, and the smaller island of Comino, characterized by nearly pristine natural environments. The landscape is dominated by limestone formations, rugged coastlines, and an arid Mediterranean climate, with strong exposure to winds and few permanent waterways. To understand Malta's identity, it is necessary to begin with the first traces of human settlement dating back to the Neolithic, among the oldest in Mediterranean Europe, with megalithic sites such as Haġar Qim and Mnajdra, which testify to a developed and autonomous prehistoric culture. Subsequently, the archipelago underwent a long sequence of external dominations and influences: Phoenicians, Carthaginians, and Romans, who integrated Malta into the trading systems of the central Mediterranean. During the Roman period, the island became a strategic maritime and administrative hub. In the Middle Ages, Malta came under Byzantine and later Arab control, a period during which linguistic and agricultural elements, still present in the local culture, consolidated. In 1530, the archipelago was entrusted to the Order of St. John, known as the Knights Hospitaller, who transformed the island into an advanced military fortress in the Mediterranean. The capital, Valletta, was founded in the 16th century after the Great Siege of 1565, a decisive event in the history of European defense against Ottoman expansion. In the 19th century Malta came under British control, becoming a strategic naval base in the Mediterranean until independence in 1964 and the subsequent proclamation of the Republic in 1974.

In this framework, the Maltese territory is divided into a unitary island system, without internal administrative macro-regions, but with a coherent functional subdivision:

- MALTA ISLAND (POLITICAL AND ECONOMIC CENTER) – INCLUDES THE CAPITAL VALLETTA AND THE SURROUNDING URBAN AREA, AS WELL AS HISTORIC CENTERS SUCH AS MDINA AND BIRGU, WITH A COASTAL FORTIFICATION SYSTEM UNIQUE IN THE MEDITERRANEAN
- GOZO (RURAL AND HISTORICAL AREA) – CHARACTERISED BY HILLY LANDSCAPES, MORE NATURAL COASTLINES AND CENTRES SUCH AS VICTORIA (RABAT GOZO), WITH A STRONG AGRICULTURAL AND CULTURAL IDENTITY
- COMINO (PROTECTED NATURAL AREA) – ALMOST UNINHABITED, WITH COASTAL ENVIRONMENTS AND THE FAMOUS BLUE LAGOON, REPRESENTS THE NATURALISTIC COMPONENT OF THE ISLAND SYSTEM

AS REGARDS THE MAIN ACCESS POINTS, THE CONNECTION NETWORK IS CONCENTRATED AND FUNCTIONAL TO THE ISLAND DIMENSION:

- Malta International Airport – Main international entry point located between Luqa and the capital, connected to all major European and Mediterranean destinations
- Ports of Valletta and Ċirkewwa – Main maritime accesses to Gozo and regional routes

In short, Malta is a unified island system in which history, sea, and territory are inseparable: from prehistoric megalithic structures to the fortifications of the Knights, up to contemporary European modernity, the archipelago represents a continuous stratification of civilizations in the heart of the Mediterranean.

# WHEN TO TRAVEL TO MALTA



**Spring** in Malta marks a transitional phase in which the climate stabilises and the islands gradually become more accessible after the more variable winter months. The landscape features mild temperatures, active vegetation, and lower tourist pressure compared to the summer season. It is a period well suited to itineraries across coastal towns, historic centres, and rural areas that are still relatively uncrowded.

**Summer** represents the peak period in terms of accessibility and vibrancy across the islands. The Mediterranean coastline becomes fully usable, with stable weather conditions and consistently warm temperatures that are generally more moderate than those experienced in continental heatwaves. This season is characterised by long days and a strong continuity of outdoor activities.

**Autumn** introduces a more balanced travel phase, with still favourable weather conditions but a significant reduction in visitor numbers. Urban areas become easier to explore, while coastal landscapes maintain mild temperatures and a calmer rhythm. It is an ideal period for those seeking a more structured and less crowded travel experience, with greater continuity in visiting sites.

**Winter** in Malta remains generally accessible and relatively mild compared to most European destinations. The islands offer more moderate climatic conditions than mainland Europe, allowing for a quieter experience focused on cultural exploration and longer stays in specific locations rather than frequent movement between sites.

# THE STUDY AND LANGUAGE IMMERSION EXPERIENCE IN MALTA

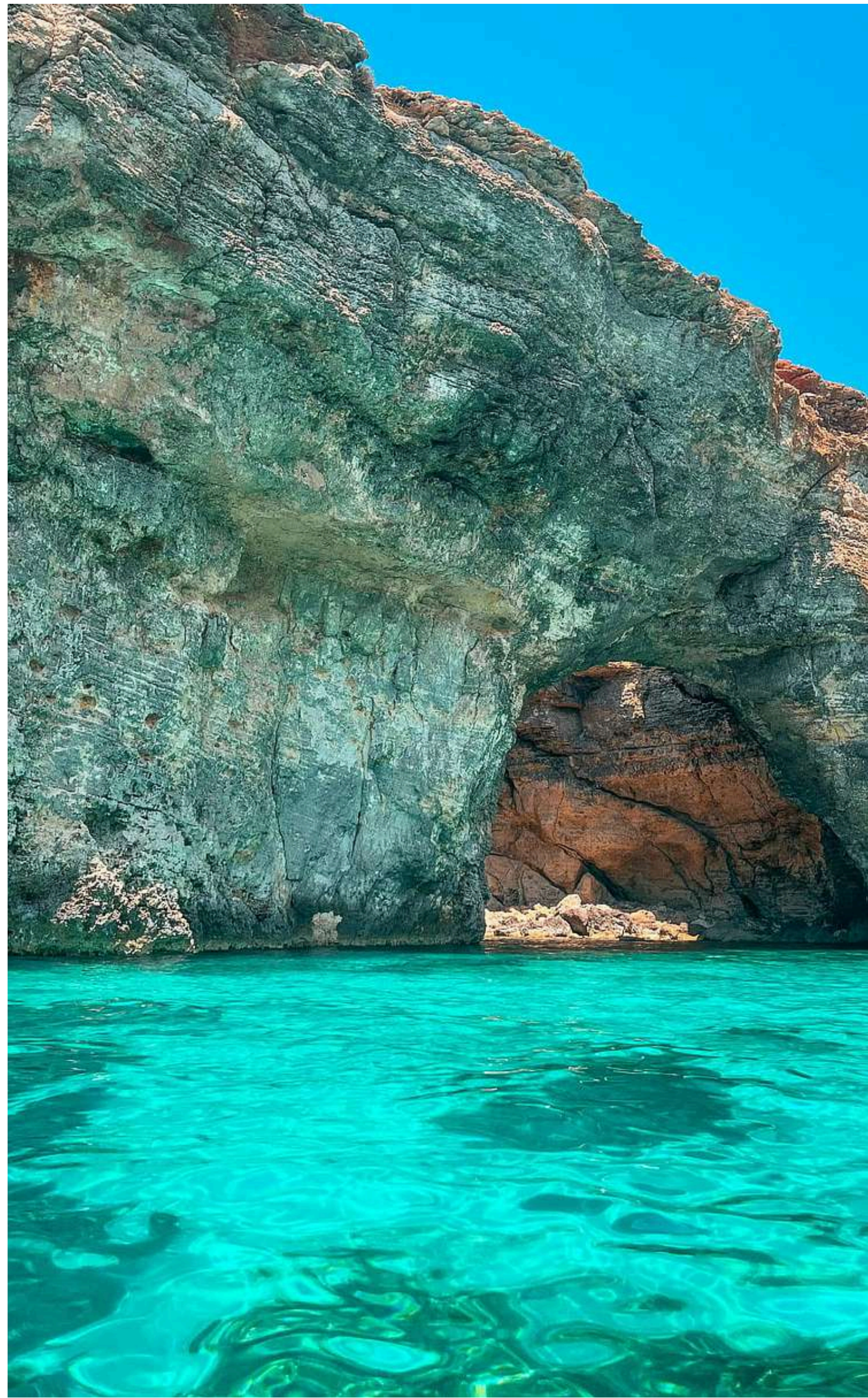
Studying English in Malta means experiencing the language in an international, Mediterranean, and dynamic context, where learning is combined with the sea, a mild climate, and a relaxed lifestyle strongly shaped by cultural exchange.

In Sliema and St. Julian's, the main centres for English language study, the learning experience unfolds in a modern and lively environment, characterised by international schools, seaside promenades, commercial areas, and districts frequented by students from all over the world. Here, English is lived daily in cafés, social activities, and multicultural settings that encourage constant immersion in the language. In Valletta, the capital of Malta and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, studying takes place in a more historic and cultural setting, among fortifications, baroque palaces, and ancient streets overlooking the Mediterranean, where the island's international dimension coexists with a strong historical identity.

Alongside the main locations, quieter areas of the archipelago also offer a more authentic and relaxed language experience, ideal for those wishing to experience Malta away from the busier zones, while still maintaining constant exposure to English and local life.

## A JOURNEY BEYOND THE LANGUAGE COURSE: AUTHENTIC EXPERIENCES AND DESTINATIONS IN MALTA DESIGNED FOR EVERY CATEGORY OF ENGLISH LANGUAGE STUDENTS

- **Parents of junior students:** Malta offers a safe and easily accessible environment. Walks along the historic walls of Valletta, the Upper Barrakka Gardens, and the calm bays of Mellieha allow the island to be experienced in a relaxed and family-friendly way.
- **Teenagers:** the journey becomes a discovery of sea and adventure. The Blue Lagoon of Comino, with its turquoise waters, and the panoramic Dingli Cliffs offer spectacular scenery far from urban centres, while small villages such as Marsaxlokk still preserve the traditional atmosphere of Malta's fishing harbours.
- **University students:** St. Julian's and Sliema represent the heart of the island's international life, with seafront venues, beach clubs, cultural events, and areas such as Spinola Bay and Paceville creating a young, multicultural environment where study and social life continuously intersect.
- **Adults:** the journey can extend to Gozo, the most authentic and tranquil island of the archipelago, where stone villages, secluded bays such as Ramla Bay, and scenic walking trails reveal a slower and more traditional Mediterranean lifestyle.
- **Professionals:** Malta offers a unique balance between Mediterranean culture and an international dimension. From ancient fortified cities such as Mdina, known as the "Silent City", to small harbours and the rocky southern coastline, the journey becomes an experience that connects history, sea, and everyday local life.





## DID YOU KNOW?

In Malta, English is one of the country's official languages alongside Maltese, a legacy of the long period of British presence that still leaves a visible mark on the education system, road signage, and everyday life.

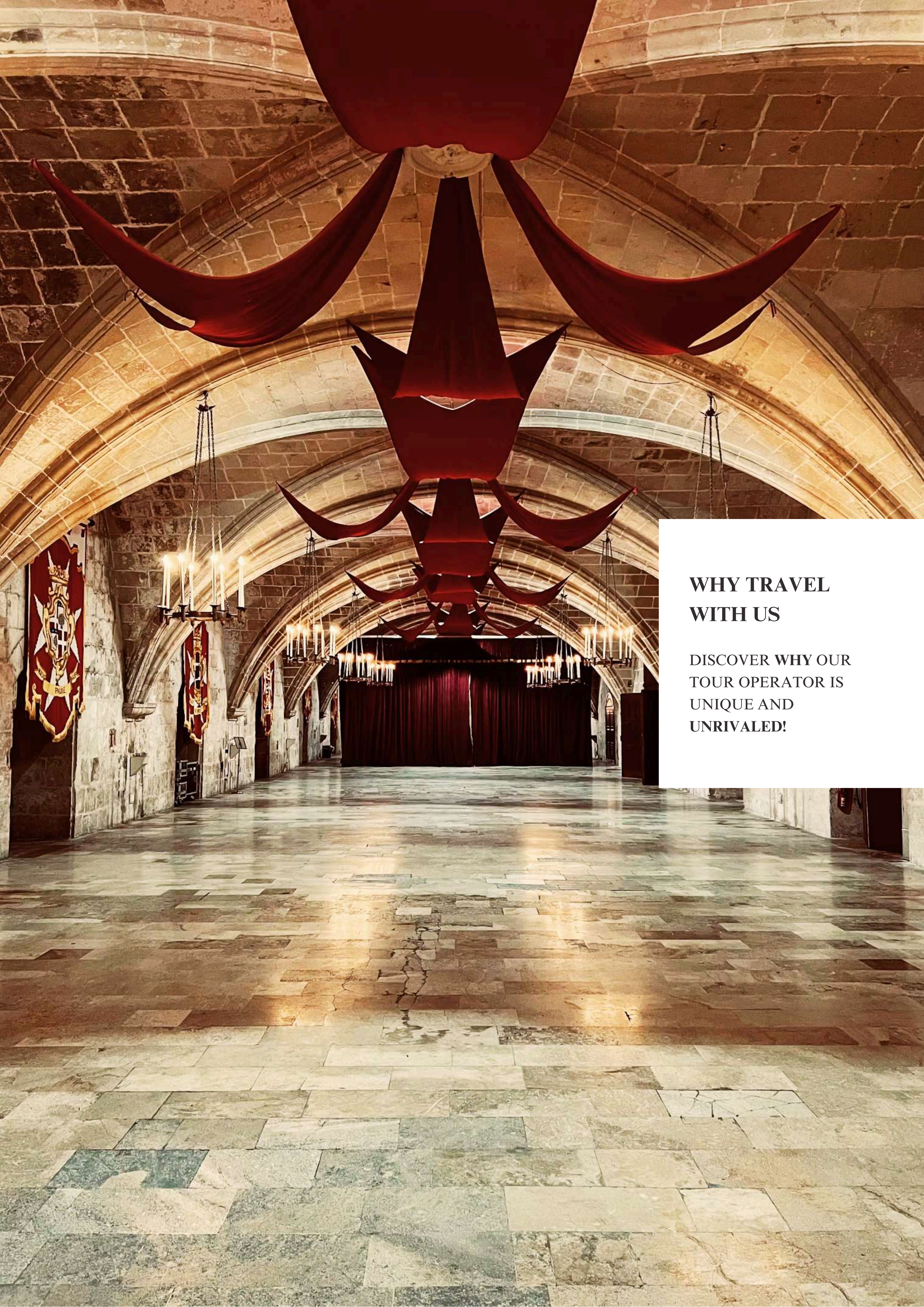
In Valletta, the island's capital and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, many of the fortifications and bastions were built by the Knights of St. John after the Great Siege of 1565, one of the most important historical events in the Mediterranean.

Also in Valletta, the Upper Barrakka Gardens offer one of the most famous panoramic views over the Grand Harbour, where ceremonial cannon shots are still fired daily as part of a long-standing tradition.

In Mdina, known as the "Silent City," the medieval centre is characterised by narrow streets, noble palaces, and ancient walls that make it one of the most atmospheric locations in the entire archipelago.

On the island of Gozo, the landscape is much more rural and peaceful than mainland Malta, with small stone villages, secluded bays, and archaeological sites such as the Ġgantija Temples, considered among the oldest megalithic structures in the world.

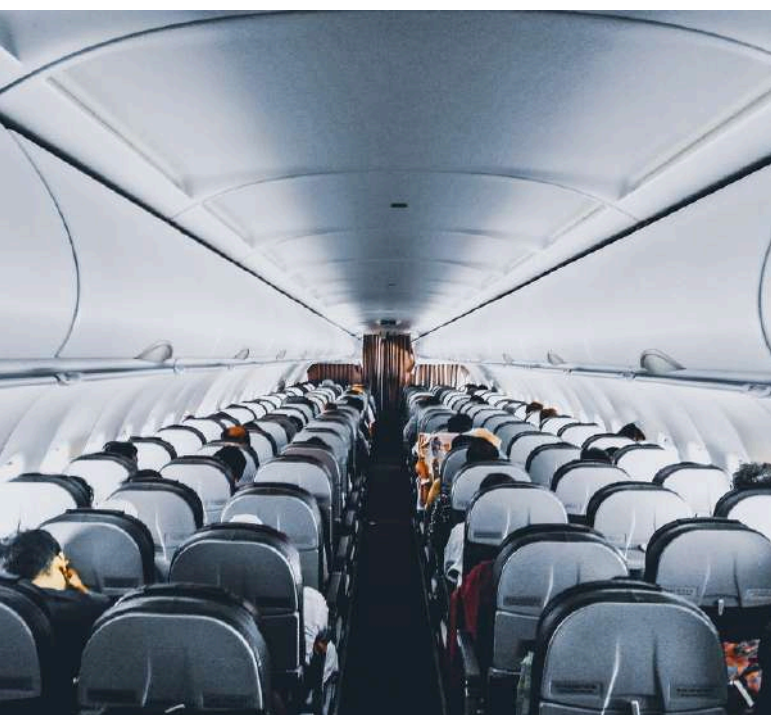
In the village of Marsaxlokk, traditional colourful fishing boats known as luzzu are still used by local fishermen today and are recognisable by the painted eyes on their bows, a symbol linked to ancient Mediterranean traditions of protection at sea.
