ST. GEORGE'S, CRYSTAL CAVES



*In Bermuda, a journey is built through close-up details and intimate experiences, where every day alternates sea, nature, and small, unexpected discoveries. The archipelago lends itself to slow and refined tourism, featuring coves hidden among the pink rocks, crystal-clear caves, and panoramic viewpoints that suddenly open onto the deep ocean. Here, a journey can become a discreet exploration of secret coastlines, a dive into subterranean landscapes like the Crystal Caves, or a discovery of historic villages like St. George's, where time seems to have stratified. Similarly, the hinterland of Harrington Sound and the beaches of the South Shore offer diverse yet complementary landscapes, all united by a sense of elegant isolation. Bermuda thus lends itself to tailor-made experiences: moments of pure nature, uncrowded coastal routes, and stops in places that reveal a more intimate and sophisticated Atlantic.*

# TRAVEL IDEAS FOR EVERYONE

## **FOR HONEYMOONS - BETWEEN PINK COVES AND TURQUOISE WATER CAVES**

In Bermuda, the honeymoon unfolds along the South Shore, where beaches like Warwick Long Bay and the hidden coves of Jobson's Cove alternate with windswept pink cliffs. Here, the sea is always close, but never the same: it shifts between secret coves and stretches of pale sand nestled between the rocks. The experience becomes even more intimate in the Crystal Caves, where underground lakes reflect stalactites suspended in an unreal light, and along the less traveled paths of Harrington Sound, where water seeps into the earth, creating profound silences. It's a journey built on secluded, almost hidden places, where each stop seems to belong only to those who experience it.

## **FOR ANNIVERSARIES AND VOW RENEWALS - BETWEEN LONELY LIGHTHOUSES AND WIND-SCULPTED OCEANS**

In Bermuda, vow renewal finds its most intense dimension along the South Shore, where the cliffs of Gibbs Hill Lighthouse offer views of the deep, ever-changing Atlantic, and where small, hidden corners like Chaplin Bay offer the sensation of being suspended between rock and sea. The atmosphere becomes even more intimate in the quiet coves of Harrington Sound, where the water moves slowly between land and vegetation, and in the historic surroundings of St. George's, among cobbled alleys and small colonial squares far from the beaten path. It's a context that transforms every moment into a discreet ritual, framed by an island that thrives on details rather than grand displays.

## **FOR OVER 65S - BETWEEN HANGING GARDENS AND TRANQUIL ATLANTIC COASTS**

In Bermuda, the pace naturally adapts to a slow journey, where every journey is short but rich in views. In St. George's, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, the cobblestone streets and small colonial squares are a leisurely stroll, amidst historic buildings and quiet harbors. Along the South Shore, scenic spots like those near Horseshoe Bay and Warwick Long Bay offer a glimpse of the sea without strenuous hikes, while the gardens and green spaces of the hinterland offer respite from tropical vegetation. Harrington Sound, with its calm and protected inland waters, also offers a secluded and easily accessible landscape, ideal for a relaxed and contemplative exploration.

## **FOR TRAVELERS WITH DISABILITIES - BETWEEN ACCESSIBLE COASTS AND UNOBSTRUCTED VIEWS**

In Bermuda, many of the most evocative experiences are concentrated in easily accessible areas, where the landscape opens up directly from the road or from well-connected vantage points. In St. George's, the UNESCO-listed historic center offers easy access to marinas, plazas, and colonial buildings. Along the South Shore, some of the most iconic beaches, such as those around Horseshoe Bay, offer dedicated access and waterfront lookouts, while areas in Warwick Parish allow you to experience the coast through natural lookouts without the need for complex routes. Harrington Sound also offers a landscape experience through scenic drives and short stops, where the water opens up between the land in continuous and easily accessible glimpses, making the island ideal for seamless and barrier-free discovery.





**PET FRIENDLY - BETWEEN PINK CLIFFS AND OCEANFRONT TRAILS**

In Bermuda, traveling with pets is naturally intertwined with the island's coastal setting, where wide open spaces and scenic routes allow for slow, continuous discovery. Along the South Shore, stretches like those around Warwick Long Bay offer walks along pale sand and sculpted rocks, with the ocean always just steps away. Even the quieter areas of Harrington Sound offer itineraries immersed in greenery and tranquility, along back roads and inland water views, while some trails near St. George's allow for a mix of urban strolls and sea views, in an orderly and never chaotic setting.

**FOR SINGLES, COUPLES, AND FAMILIES - BETWEEN HIDDEN COVES, VILLAGES, AND A SEA OF LIGHT**

In Bermuda, a journey is built between micro-places that constantly change atmosphere. Singles will find the St. George's area a maze of historic alleys and small harborside bars, where life flows discreetly yet vibrantly, while couples wander the coves of the South Shore, like Warwick Long Bay and Jobson's Cove, where the sea laps between pink rocks and pale sand. Families can explore the island through simple yet evocative experiences: the calm waters of Harrington Sound, the sheltered beaches around Horseshoe Bay, and visits to the Crystal Caves, where underground lakes and crystal formations create a surprising and accessible natural environment.



# GREENLAND

Greenland is not a destination in the traditional sense, but a vast, primordial space where nature still dictates every rhythm. In autumn, when the Arctic summer slowly retreats, the landscape transforms into a rarefied combination of ice, colorful tundra, and skies that begin to deepen, anticipating the season of the Northern Lights. Along the coasts and in the western fjords, enormous icebergs move silently across dark, transparent waters, while small settlements like Ilulissat, Nuuk, and the southern communities gather in a minimalist dimension, made of isolation and resistance. Here, the journey follows not roads, but sea routes, short paths, and air connections that bridge immense distances. Greenland in autumn is an experience of subtraction and intensity: slanting light, profound silences, and landscapes that change shape without warning. It is a land you travel not to see, but to perceive, where every element—ice, wind, sea, and sky—becomes part of a single, vast horizon.





# WHERE THE LIGHT DRAWS THE ICE

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ILULISSAT, DISKO BAY, NUUK, QAQORTOQ, NARSARSUAQ



*In Greenland, the journey unfolds through a few intense places, where every journey becomes an experience. There are no linear itineraries: you move from the western fjords to the southern coasts, from small, isolated communities to endless expanses of ice, always accompanied by a nature that dominates and transforms every perception. Experiences are concentrated around Ilulissat and its Icefjord, among imposing icebergs slowly drifting into the sea, or around Nuuk, where the Arctic landscape intertwines with the daily life of the world's northernmost capital. In the south, between Narsarsuaq and Qaqortoq, Greenland becomes softer, with green valleys, deep fjords, and a more accessible yet still remote dimension. It is a destination that lends itself to tailor-made trips, including sailing through the ice, short excursions into the tundra, and moments of pure observation, where silence and light become central to the experience.*

# TRAVEL IDEAS FOR EVERYONE

## **FOR HONEYMOONS - AMONG SILENT ICEBERGS AND FJORDS OF THE ILULISSAT ICEFJORD**

In Ilulissat, overlooking the eponymous UNESCO Icefjord, honeymoons unfold amid slow sailings among monumental icebergs that break away from the Sermeq Kujalleq glacier and drift into the sea like living sculptures. Here, silence isn't the absence of sound, but total presence, interrupted only by the crackling of the ice and the movement of the Arctic waters. Couples can enjoy secluded experiences along the fjords, with short boat excursions through the waters of Disko Bay or stops at scenic spots where the tundra glows red and gold. It's an essential journey, built on light, ice, and seemingly suspended distances.

## **FOR ANNIVERSARIES AND VOW RENEWALS - BETWEEN NUUK AND THE SOUTHERN FJORDS**

In Nuuk, the world's northernmost capital, the vow renewal takes place in a surprising setting, where the sea enters the city and the mountains emerge directly from the ocean. The celebrations take place between the waterfront and the surrounding small bays, in a rare balance between contemporary life and Arctic nature. In southern Greenland, between Qaqortoq and Narsarsuaq, the fjords become softer and deeper, framed by green valleys and low mountains. Here, the journey takes on a more intimate dimension, with scenes alternating between distant ice and almost pastoral landscapes.

## **FOR OVER 65S - ACCESSIBLE GREENLAND BETWEEN ILULISSAT AND NUUK**

Greenland can be experienced through a few key but well-connected points. In Ilulissat, panoramic walkways over the Icefjord allow for easy viewing of the icebergs, while short guided cruises offer a quick glimpse of the landscape. In Nuuk, the city center and waterfront offer a slow and organized exploration, including the museum, harbor, and ocean views. Even in the south, in Qaqortoq, the short distances and compact village structure make the experience accessible and contemplative.

## **FOR TRAVELERS WITH DISABILITIES - BETWEEN ARCTIC CITIES AND ICE OBSERVATION**

In Nuuk, the waterfront and some urban areas allow for easy enjoyment of the coastal landscape, with direct views of the fjords without the need for demanding trails. Museums and cultural spaces also offer accessibility in a well-organized setting. In Ilulissat, the Icefjord viewpoints are accessible via short, structured trails, ideal for observing icebergs from close range without complex hikes. It's an experience based on observation, rather than movement.





**PET FRIENDLY - BETWEEN ARCTIC SPACES AND BOUNDLESS NATURE**

Greenland offers vast natural spaces where contact with the environment is direct and continuous. Around Nuuk and in the southern villages, open areas and coastal paths allow for uncrowded enjoyment of the landscape. Nature here is essential and free of artificial barriers: tundra, fjords, and open spaces become the backdrop for a shared journey, where the Arctic silence accompanies every move.

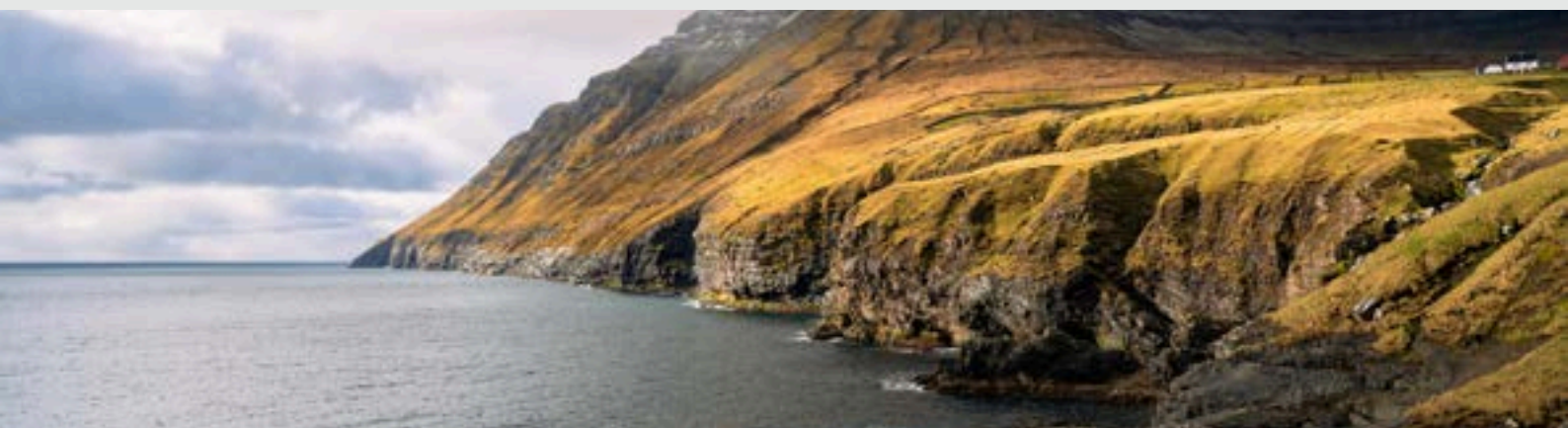
**FOR SINGLES, COUPLES, AND FAMILIES - BETWEEN TUNDRA, ICE, AND REMOTE VILLAGES**

In Nuuk, single travelers find a simple yet charming urban setting, nestled between the harbor, fjords, and small local communities. Couples head toward Ilulissat, where the glacial landscape becomes a natural backdrop for slow sailing and profound silence. Families can enjoy guided experiences among the fjords of Disko Bay, safely observing icebergs and Arctic wildlife, or explore the villages of the south, where Greenland opens up to gentler and more accessible landscapes.



# FAROE ISLANDS

The Faroe Islands emerge in the North Atlantic as a remote and magnetic archipelago, suspended between Iceland and Norway, where the landscape seems shaped more by wind than by man. In every season, the light changes rapidly, passing through low clouds, sudden openings, and skies reflecting on deep fjords and vertical cliffs that drop directly into the ocean. Here, nature is never a stage set, but an all-encompassing presence: green meadows that suddenly end before the sea, villages of wooden houses with grass roofs that seem to dissolve into the landscape, roads that pass through tunnels and mountains as if they were part of the archipelago's very geology. From the cliffs of Vagar to the suspended villages of Gjógv and Saksun, to the discreet vitality of Tórshavn, the Faroes offer a spare and powerful journey, where silence, rain, and wind become constant elements of a deeply immersive experience, off the beaten track.





# WHERE THE WIND SCULPTS THE LANDSCAPE

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VÁGAR, STREYMOY AND TÓRSHAVN, EYSTUROY, NORTH AND  
INNER ARCHIPELAGO



*In the Faroe Islands, travel is constructed through short distances but intense scenery, where every bend in the road opens onto sudden fjords, isolated villages, and cliffs that plunge seamlessly into the ocean. There are no long journeys, but rather a continuous sequence of essential places, often reached through tunnels dug into the mountain or roads that follow the rugged contours of the coastline. Experiences are concentrated between the villages of Gjógv, suspended above a natural gorge that opens towards the sea, Saksun, nestled in a lagoon surrounded by gentle, silent mountains, and the island of Vágur, where waterfalls like Múlafossur fall directly into the ocean. In Tórshavn, the capital, the journey takes on a more intimate feel, amidst small harbors, wooden houses, and a discreet yet authentic local life. The Faroe Islands lend themselves to slow, continuous exploration, made up of panoramas that change rapidly with the light and weather, and essential experiences, where the landscape becomes the true protagonist and every move is already part of the journey.*

# TRAVEL IDEAS FOR EVERYONE

## **FOR HONEYMOONS - BETWEEN HANGING WATERFALLS AND VILLAGES OVERLOOKING THE OCEAN**

In the Faroe Islands, a honeymoon unfolds amidst landscapes seemingly suspended between sky and sea. On the island of Vágar, the Múlafossur waterfall in Gásadalur falls directly into the ocean in an almost unreal balance, framed by green meadows and absolute silence. Couples can continue to Gjógv, where colorful wooden houses overlook a natural gorge opening towards the Atlantic, or travel the scenic roads connecting the northern islets, passing through tunnels, fjords, and stretches of completely deserted coastline. It's a journey of essence, where nature doesn't accompany the experience: it defines it.

## **FOR ANNIVERSARIES AND VOW RENEWALS - BETWEEN SAKSUN AND THE NORTH ATLANTIC CLIFFS**

In the village of Saksun, nestled between rolling mountains and a lagoon that changes with the tides, vow renewal takes on a secluded feel, almost suspended in time. The ancient grass-roofed farmhouses amplify the feeling of isolation and tranquility. On the western shores of Eysturoy and along the cliffs of Vestmanna, the ocean opens up in vertical cliffs and sea caves accessible only by boat, where the wind and waves become part of the ritual. It's an experience built on pure landscapes, far removed from any form of spectacularization.

## **FOR OVER 65S - THE SLOW FAROE ISLANDS BETWEEN TÓRSHAVN AND COASTAL VIEWS**

In Tórshavn, one of the world's smallest capitals, the journey takes in small harbors, historic houses, and intimate museums, in a simple and easily navigable urban setting. The scenic roads connecting the main islands allow for frequent stops at observation points overlooking fjords and cliffs, while villages like Gjógv offer a slow and accessible experience, where the landscape can be admired without the need for demanding routes.

## **FOR TRAVELERS WITH DISABILITIES - BETWEEN COMPACT CAPITALS AND ACCESSIBLE PANORAMAS**

In Tórshavn, the historic center and waterfront offer easy access to the urban and coastal landscape, with compact, easily navigable spaces. Many of the Faroe Islands' scenic spots are accessible directly from the road, with observation points along the main roads connecting Eysturoy, Streymoy, and Vágar, allowing you to experience the fjords, cliffs, and waterfalls without the need for complex treks.

Further north, silent fjords and isolated villages reveal a more intimate and remote Iceland, far from the beaten track. From Reykjavik to the great Golden Circle itineraries, to the lesser-visited regions of the North and East, Iceland offers a simple and powerful travel experience, where nature is never a backdrop, but rather the absolute protagonist and constant transformation of the landscape.

Experiences are concentrated along the south coast, between Vik and the black sands of Reynisfjara, where the ocean meets basalt cliffs and natural arches, or along the Golden Circle, between Geysir, Gullfoss, and Þingvellir National Park, where geology becomes a continuous spectacle. Further east and north, the Eastfjords and Akureyri regions offer a more remote Iceland, made of silent fjords and small towns suspended between sea and mountains. It is a destination that lends itself to tailor-made itineraries, including seamless panoramic roads, stops at iconic natural sites, and moments of pure observation, where the landscape becomes a total and constant experience.*

## **FOR HONEYMOONS - BETWEEN HANGING WATERFALLS AND THE BLACK SANDS OF REYNISFJARA**

In Iceland, honeymoons take place along the south coast, where Seljalandsfoss waterfall allows you to walk behind the veil of water and experience the landscape from an intimate and unique perspective. A little further on, Skógafoss opens like a vertical wall of water, often shrouded in sudden rainbows that change with the light. Couples can continue toward the black sands of Reynisfjara, among basalt columns and Atlantic waves crashing with primordial force, or reach the glacial lagoons of Jökulsárlón, where blue icebergs drift slowly toward the ocean. It's a journey built on essential elements, where nature becomes a continuous gesture.

## **FOR ANNIVERSARIES AND VOW RENEWALS - BETWEEN ÞINGVELLIR AND ICE LAGOONS**

In Þingvellir National Park, where tectonic plates are visibly separating, vow renewal takes on a rare symbolic value, immersed in a unique geological landscape. In rural England, the Cotswolds and the Lake District offer a softer landscape, made up of stone villages and lakes nestled among hills. It is a destination that lends itself to tailor-made trips, where each stop is a fragment of landscape and each route becomes a visual narrative of nature, history, and profound silence.*

## **FOR HONEYMOONS - BETWEEN THE SCOTTISH HIGHLANDS AND HIDDEN LOCHS**

Autumn in Norway combines adventure and comfort: fjord cruises, stays in nature-immersed lodges, culinary experiences based on local produce and encounters with a culture deeply connected to the sea and the mountains. The contrast between the ocean, forests and Arctic landscapes makes this season particularly atmospheric. It is also the time when Norway reveals its most authentic side: less hurried, quieter and wrapped in a unique light. A journey through wild nature, Nordic traditions and landscapes that seem suspended between earth and sky.





# WHERE NATURE BECOMES VERTICAL AND SILENT

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HJØRUNDFJORD, SUNNMØRE, HARDANGERFJORD, HELGELAND, VEGAØYAN,  
LOFOTEN, TELEMARK, BERGEN AND ÅLESUND



*In Norway, travel takes place far from the beaten track, following secondary fjords, remote villages, and roads that disappear between mountains and ocean. It's a land that invites you to detour, to choose less frequented coasts and inlets where human presence is reduced to small, discreet features in the landscape. Along the Helgeland coast, between suspension bridges and little-traveled archipelagos like Vegaøyen, the sea fragments into hundreds of silent islands. Further south, lesser-known fjords like Hjørundfjord, nestled among the mountains of the Sunnmøre Alps, offer a more intimate and vertical Norway, far from the more traditional tourist routes. Even the inland regions of Telemark, with wooden villages and lakes hidden among the forests, reveal a more secluded and surprising side of the country. In the far north, Svalbard (Longyearbyen) represents the journey's most extreme threshold: an Arctic frontier of tundra, ice, and absolute silence, where even a brief outing beyond the city limits becomes an experience of pure exploration. This is a pared-down, hidden Norway, to be explored slowly, exploring places that don't seek attention but deserve it.*

# TRAVEL IDEAS FOR EVERYONE

## **FOR HONEYMOONS - BETWEEN HJØRUNDFJORD AND THE HANGING VILLAGES OF THE SUNNMØRE ALPS**

In Norway, the honeymoon ventures off the beaten track to enter the vertical silence of the Hjørundfjord, a fjord nestled in the Sunnmøre Alps, where mountains drop steeply into the water and small villages like Urke and Sæbø seem suspended between reflections and rock faces. Here, the journey unfolds between slow sailings on dark, transparent waters, stays in isolated lodges accessible only by fjord, and stops at scenic spots where the landscape doesn't open up: it imposes itself. This is an intimate, secluded Norway, where every element becomes part of an essential and deeply immersive experience.

## **FOR ANNIVERSARIES AND VOW RENEWALS - BETWEEN VEGAØYAN AND HELGELAND, A SECRET**

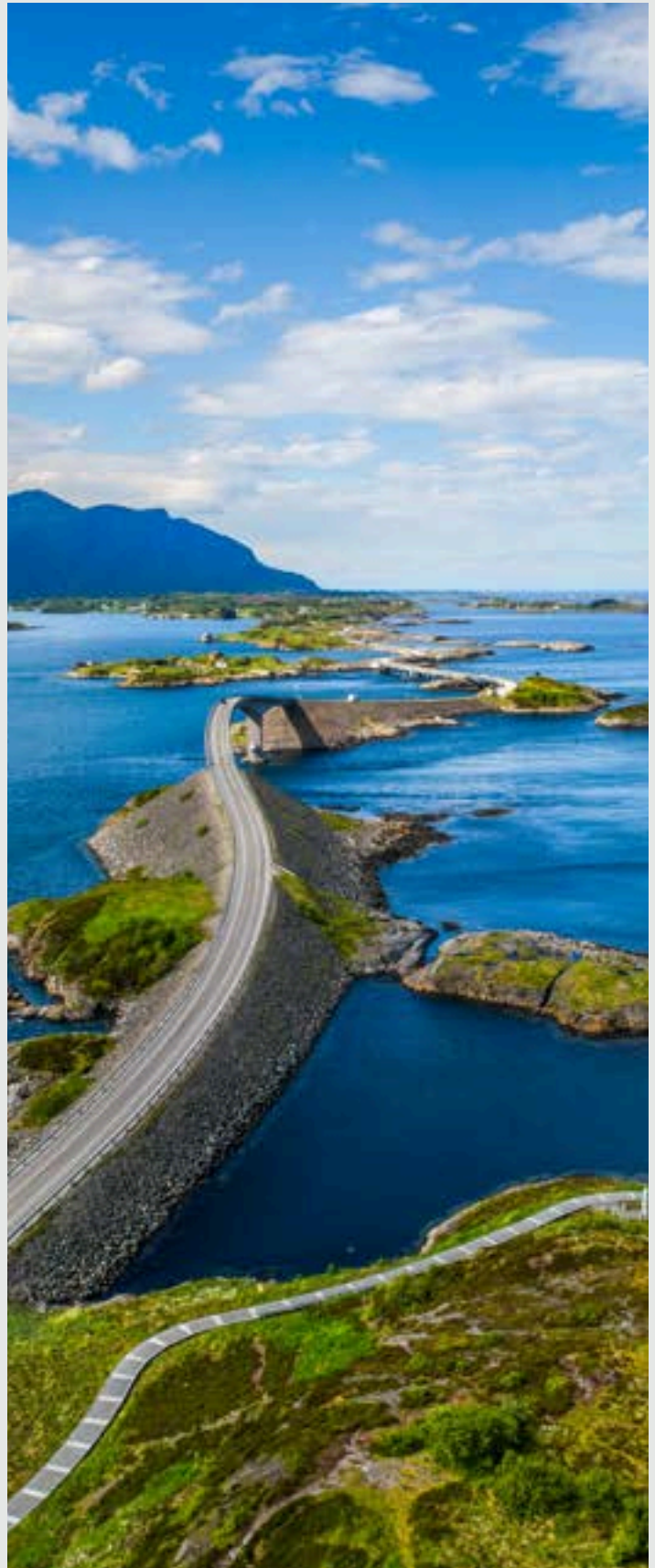
In the less traveled north, the Vegaøyane archipelago, a UNESCO World Heritage site, offers a landscape of tiny islands, wooden houses, and horizons that continually break between sea and sky. Here, vow renewal takes on a secluded, almost suspended dimension. Along the coast of Helgeland, between islands like Støtt and stretches of sea dotted with rocky islets, the journey transforms into a series of silent landings. The Torghatten mountains, with their famous natural hole, add a symbolic and rare element, far from the most traveled routes.

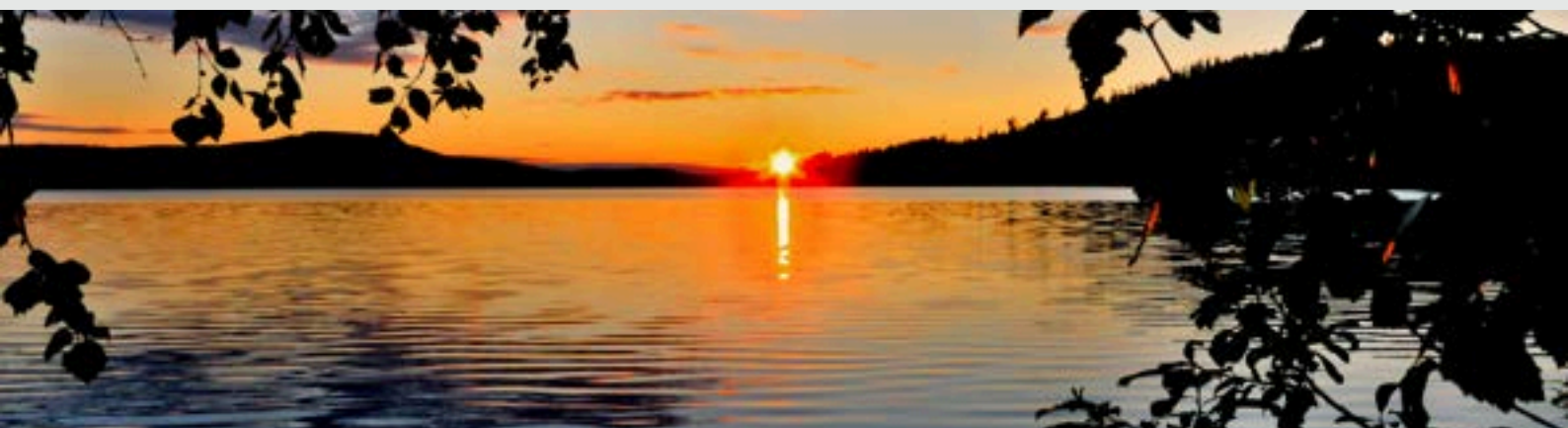

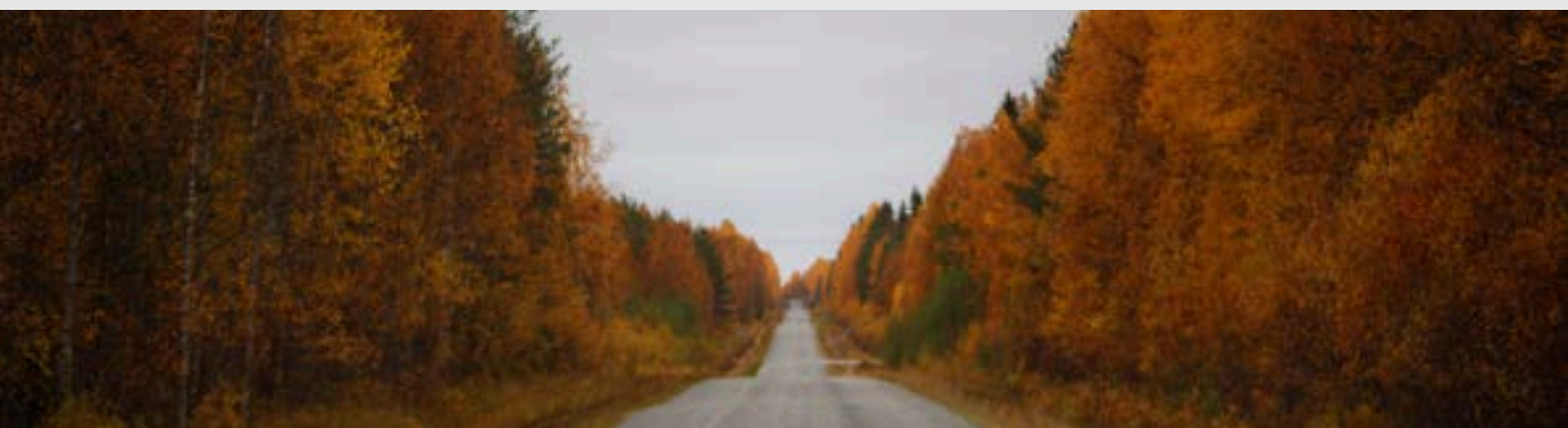

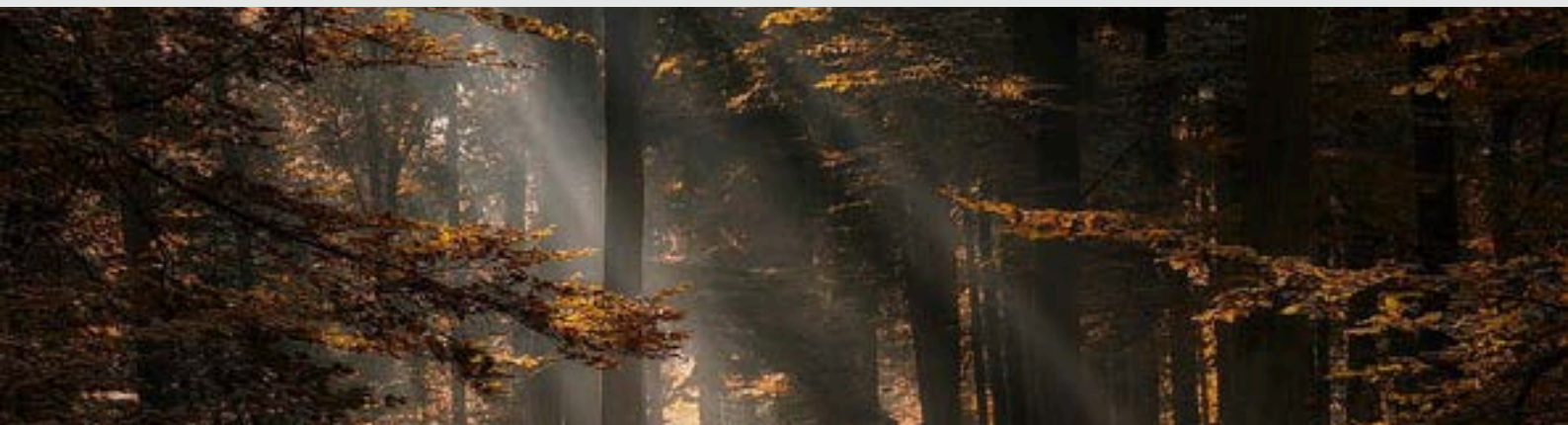

In Gran Canaria, the areas of Maspalomas and Las Palmas offer accessible urban and coastal routes, with long, flat walks among dunes, ocean, and city.

At the Egyptian Museum in Cairo and in the modern part of the city, the journey focuses on urban spaces where the main cultural attractions can be accessed via organized tours. On the Red Sea, locations like Marsa Alam offer modern facilities and flat coastal areas, where the connection with the sea is experienced directly and comfortably, amid beaches and coral reefs that can be observed even without complex diving.





**PET FRIENDLY - BETWEEN DESERT OASES AND THE BANKS OF THE NILE**

In the rural areas along the Upper Nile, between farming villages and palm-shaded banks, the landscape unfolds in open, continuous spaces, where the journey follows the rhythm of the river. Even in the Siwa area and on the edges of the Western Desert, the natural setting offers wide, silent expanses and slow-paced routes, where nature reigns supreme and the journey becomes an essential experience.

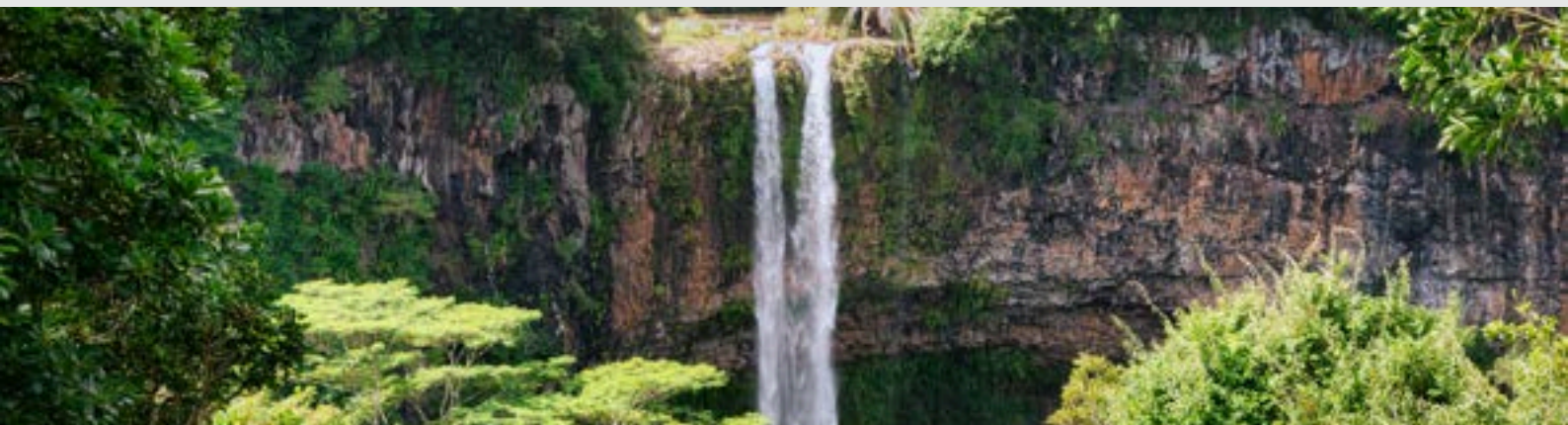
**FOR SINGLES, COUPLES, AND FAMILIES - BETWEEN SECRET LUXOR AND THE HIDDEN RED SEA**

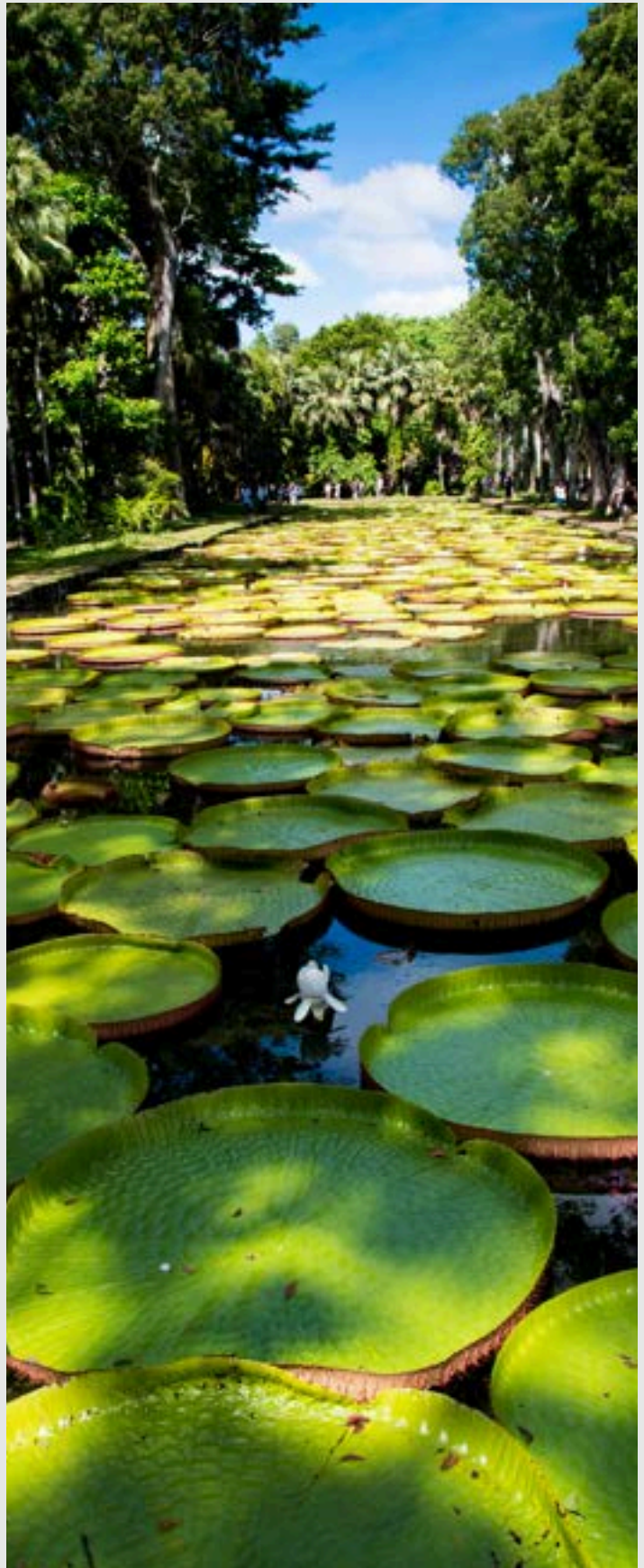

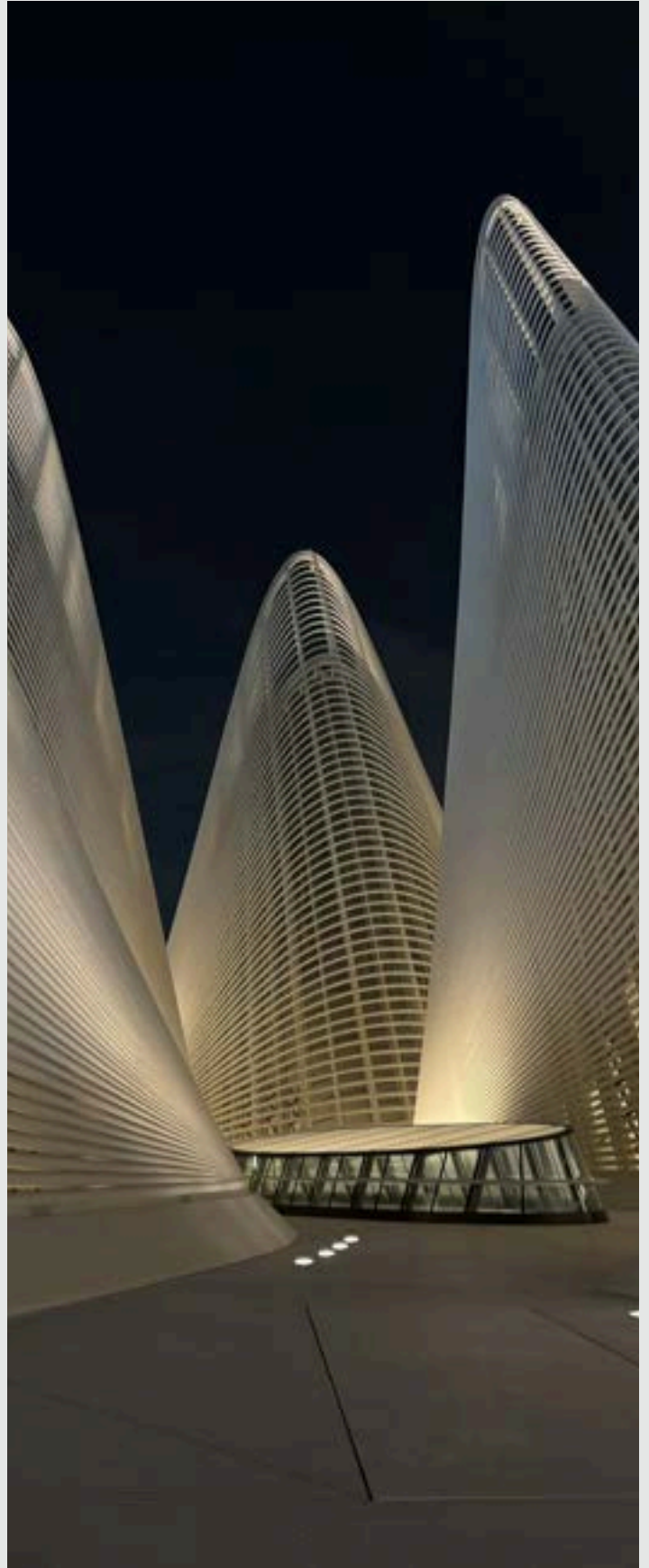
