From the rugged coastline of Kristiansand to the secret islands of Lofoten, to the icy expanses of Svalbard, Norway offers a mosaic of extreme geographies where the landscape is not just a backdrop, but a central focus. Navigating these waters means traversing age-old routes marked by fishermen, whalers, and migrants, in lands where time has a different rhythm and light shapes every experience.

Among floating villages, cliffs populated by Arctic birds, and bays accessible only by sea, you come into contact with a humanity that has transformed isolation into strength, and with a nature that demands respect and wonder. Arctic cruises and small coastal yachts become tools for exploring the landscape, listening to its stories, and discovering a north that is much more than ice and silence: it is a laboratory of adaptation, sustainability, and living memory.

Departing from the lively and history-rich port of **Kristiansand**, you'll soon sail toward **Flekkerøy**, a nearby island where fine sandy beaches, coastal paths, and historic fortresses invite you to stroll and snorkel in the crystal-clear waters. Continuing along the little-known archipelago of **Kvåsefjorden**, you'll stop in fishing villages like **Høvåg**, where fish markets and artisan workshops tell stories of a vibrant and authentic culture. The journey continues toward **Lyngør**, considered one of Norway's most beautiful and best-preserved villages, with its red wooden houses overlooking navigable canals. Here, it's a pleasure to explore hidden paths, visit small museums, and savor traditional dishes based on the freshest seafood. Sailing west, you'll reach the tranquil island of **Merdø**, with sandy beaches and an ancient lighthouse, perfect for outdoor picnics and refreshing swims in the clear waters. Kayakers will find its quiet coves a true paradise. The next stop takes you to **Jomfruland Nature Park**, an ideal spot for observing migratory birds and long walks through sand dunes and pine forests. A historic lighthouse and a community dedicated to fishing and organic farming complete this authentic nature experience. Finally, the voyage ends in **Risør**, a port town overlooking the fjord, famous for its classical music festival and well-preserved wooden architecture. From here, you can embark on daytime explorations to small nearby islands like **Stangholmen**, perfect for a final dip or a sunset dinner in an intimate and relaxed atmosphere.

PRE-CRUISE EXPERIENCE

Before setting sail, the journey begins with three nights in **Nusfjord**, one of Norway's oldest and best-preserved fishing villages, a designated cultural heritage site. Here, you'll stay in traditional, restored rorbuer cabins, wooden cabins by the sea that were once home to fishermen. Days are spent on guided hikes along trails that hug the fjords, sunset kayaking trips, traditional cooking workshops using local ingredients, and photo sessions in one of Northern Norway's most iconic settings. Far from mass tourism, Nusfjord welcomes you with silence, wind, and stories suspended between past and present. A perfect, intimate, and evocative preparation for getting into the rhythm of the cruise.



REASONS TO GO

This cruise takes you to the heart of the most authentic and isolated **Lofoten**, far from the busiest ports. You'll sail through fjords nestled in the rocks and coves accessible only by sea, with extended stops in places like **Værøy**, **Røst**, and **Henningsvær**, where life still follows the rhythm of the catch and the seasons. Every stop is an opportunity for encounters: you can participate in small local festivals, explore ceramic and photography studios, stroll among cliffs inhabited by puffins, or take a dinghy trip to spot whales and sea eagles. On board, nature guides and local scholars accompany the voyage with tales of geology, craftsmanship, and traditions. A cruise for those seeking a slow and mindful immersion amidst the Arctic light, vibrant culture, and primordial sea.





SVALBARD ISLANDS - A WEEKLY CRUISE TO THE EDGE OF THE WORLD, AMONG GLACIERS, TUNDRA, AND ARCTIC WILDLIFE

PRE-CRUISE EXPERIENCE

The journey begins with three nights in **Barentsburg**, the archipelago's least-visited Russian mining village, suspended between Soviet history and Arctic resilience. Here, you'll sleep in guesthouses overlooking the ice and take guided walks along the tundra coast, among reindeer, lichens, and old industrial infrastructure converted into cultural centers. You'll visit the power plant, the inactive mine, and the meteorological research center, as well as an Arctic microbrewery and a small school for local children. Amid immense silences and symbols of resistance, you'll enter the true spirit of **Svalbard**: remote, harsh, authentic. A surprising introduction, preparing you for the sea voyage with a sense of presence and wonder.



REASONS TO GO

Sailing through Svalbard is like entering a timeless world, where ice rules and every encounter with nature is extraordinary. You'll explore the western coast of Spitsbergen Island, stopping in uninhabited bays like Magdalenefjorden, Ny-Ålesund, and Liefdefjorden. Among ice caps and flowering tundra, you'll observe walruses, polar bears, whales, and arctic foxes, accompanied by expert guides and naturalists on board. The ship transforms into a mobile exploration base: daily there are Zodiac excursions, themed lectures, and moments to listen to the silence and the never-fading light. A rare, educational, and profound cruise. For those who want to see the Arctic, not just travel through it.

SWEDEN

AMONG GRANITE ISLANDS, ENDLESS ARCHIPELAGOS AND VILLAGES SUBMERGED BY GREENERY

Sweden, seen from the sea, reveals a secret face, made up of thousands of islands scattered between the Baltic and Kattegat, where the landscape is intimate, discreet, and everchanging. Sailing along these coasts means accessing isolated communities, lichen-covered rocks, forgotten lighthouses, and villages where time is measured by the passing of boats.

From the deep south of Skåne to the archipelagos of Gothenburg and Stockholm, every stretch of coastline tells stories of traders, pirates, fishermen, and artists. **Cruises** and boat itineraries lead to discovering community gardens on the islands, floating saunas, hidden trails, and authentic encounters with the people who inhabit these quiet places. A journey through nature and culture, where water is both a gateway and an inner horizon: a reflection of a country that has chosen to inhabit the sea with respect and lightness.











SWEDEN – THE WEST COAST BETWEEN SILENT ARCHIPELAGOS, BOHEMIAN VILLAGES AND NORDIC SEA CULTURE

Starting from the elegant port city of Marstrand, less traveled than Gothenburg, the route skirts the islands of the Bohuslän archipelago, a marine labyrinth of granite cliffs and colorful villages suspended between land and sea. After a first night at anchor near Dyrön, with its coastal paths, natural saunas, and free-roaming deer, the route continues to Käringön, a car-free island with charming cafes, craft markets, and a small seal conservation center. The heart of the journey arrives among the lesser-explored islands of Väderöarna, a marine reserve where you can observe gray seals, sea eagles, and perfect seabeds for snorkeling and diving. Slow stops are made in Fjällbacka, home of writer Camilla Läckberg, where among the cliffs and narrow streets you can breathe an authentic Nordic and cultural atmosphere. The final stops are the islands of Tjörn and Orust, with open-air art galleries, nature trails, timeless seaside villages, and small restaurants serving smoked herring and sweet bread. A slow, reflective, and immersive voyage through a corner of Sweden where tourism remains low-key and life still revolves around the rhythm of the sea.







SWEDISH BALTIC SEA - A WEEK-LONG CRUISE TO INVISIBLE CITIES, SECRET COASTS, AND HIDDEN NORDIC CULTURE

PRE-CRUISE EXPERIENCE

Three nights in the town of **Söderköping**, along the **Göta Canal**, offer a perfect introduction to Sweden's lesser-known side. Here, you'll stay in former inns converted into small boutique hotels, take mini-river cruises on historic vessels, and explore the canal by bike, past drawbridges and windmills. Locals tell stories of ancient trade and new forms of local tourism, among wooden shops and freshwater bookshops. In the evening, enjoy traditional dishes in restaurants on barges, while the Northern Lights reflect in the canal. An intimate, slow, and narrative way to prepare for the Baltic and its most secret route.



REASONS TO GO

This Swedish Baltic cruise avoids major ports, favoring intimate and unique stops, such as Visby on the island of Gotland, a medieval walled city with attractive cultural festivals, and Öland, a flat and poetic island with ancient windmills and bird sanctuaries. The cruise passes islets inhabited by seals, small lighthouses, and protected marine nature reserves, with stops in Kalmar, where the Renaissance castle and historic center are a laboratory of coexistence between the past and urban sustainability. The ship becomes a space for slow discovery, with onboard lectures on Baltic history and biodiversity, guided tours of coastal villages, and lunches featuring local specialties such as smoked salmon or island cheeses. There are also walks through peat bogs and birch forests, bike and kayak excursions, and moments of landscape contemplation. This cruise is for those who want to experience Sweden in depth, away from the major ferry routes, and be surprised by the quiet and profound charm of the Baltic.

FINLAND

BETWEEN SUSPENDED ISLANDS, SEASIDE SAUNAS AND BALTIC RESILIENCE

In the labyrinth of islands of the Finnish archipelago, between the bays of the southwest coast and the semi-autonomous communities of Åland, lies a geography that speaks of silence, continuity, and small daily revolutions. Sailing these waters is a way to connect with a landscape of granite and moss, calm seas and gentle winds, where every landing is an encounter.

The routes traverse little-traveled territories, between villages invisible to tourist maps and centuries-old settlements that have chosen slowness as a form of resistance. Each island holds knowledge, a memory, a community that has learned to coexist with the water. Cruises and boat itineraries become journeys into the Nordic light, among local dishes, coastal forests, and sustainable projects. A Finland that doesn't show itself, but reveals itself: step by step, wave by wave.











TURKU ARCHIPELAGO – BETWEEN SILENT ISLANDS, REMOTE LIGHTHOUSES, AND AUTHENTIC NORDIC TRADITIONS



We depart from **Turku**, the ancient Finnish capital and lively riverside city, to immerse ourselves in one of Europe's largest and most intricate archipelagos. After an initial landing at **Lillandet**, we continue towards the tranquil islands of **Nagu** and **Korpo**, where small wooden ports and sea-facing saunas introduce us to the slow pace of Baltic culture. Sailing through narrow waterways and landscapes dotted with birch trees and granite, we reach the outer islands of **Jurmo** and **Utö**, among the most remote and fascinating in the archipelago. Here, a lighthouse operating since the 19th century and a handful of colorful houses welcome travelers with absolute silence, wide skies, and sailors' tales. On the return journey, stops in **Houtskär** and **Iniö** offer walks among peat bogs and mills, encounters with local fishermen, and small artisan workshops producing candles, wool, and wild berry jams. Every evening, we drop anchor in sheltered bays, cook on board or dine in ancient coastal inns, and indulge in steaming saunas followed by rejuvenating dips in the Baltic. Depending on sea conditions, it's possible to divert to the smaller islands of **Aspö** or **Bosnäs**, even more isolated and only seasonally inhabited, where the connection to land seems to vanish entirely. Here, time is measured in waves, wind, and light, amid profound silence and infinite skies. The itinerary often includes meetings with local marine biologists, experiences gathering edible seaweed, and traditional navigation practices on small rowboats. Each day brings a different rhythm, but always guided by a feeling of total harmony between man, boat, and nature.

PRE-CRUISE EXPERIENCE

Three nights in the small village of **Naantali**, west of Turku, gracefully and slowly introduce a journey along Finland's Baltic coast. Stay in former wooden summer guesthouses overlooking the sea, complete with private saunas and direct access to small rocky beaches. During the day, explore the historic center, filled with colorful houses, artisanal cafés, and ancient piers still used by local fishermen. Take an electric boat trip in the bay to observe coastal wildlife, or join vegetable dyeing and Nordic cuisine workshops led by young artisans and chefs working to revive traditions. The days pass slowly amidst forests, markets, and rosy sunsets. An intimate and sustainable taste of Finnish coastal culture, preparing you for sailing as a rite of passage.



REASONS TO GO


This cruise traverses the most poetic and least explored part of southern Finland, sailing between the Aland Islands, the rugged coast of Kustavi, and the seaside villages of Korpo and Nagu, in the heart of the archipelago. The routes favor small, authentic landings, with the possibility of guided visits to nature reserves, local cultural centers, and communities practicing slow, rooted tourism. On board, experts in Nordic biodiversity and Baltic history lead workshops and informal discussions; on land, guests can participate in bike excursions through pine forests and pastures, sample local honey, and relax in floating saunas. Among the most exciting stops: Sottunga, the least populated of Åland, and Föglö, where you can discover ancient maritime rituals and dine in old boat hangars transformed into sustainable bistros. The voyage itself becomes contemplation: every stretch of sea, every island appearing on the horizon is an invitation to discovery, respect, and listening.

NETHERLANDS

BETWEEN INVISIBLE TIDES, CULTURAL DAMS AND ISLANDS THAT RESIST

In the Netherlands, the boundary between land and water is a constant negotiation. The Frisian Islands and the Zeeland region tell stories of ingenuity, adaptation, and landscapes that exist thanks to the will of their inhabitants. Sailing along these coasts is not just a landscape choice, but an act of listening to vulnerable territories and resilient communities.

Between brackish canals, watermills, salt pans, and villages reclaimed from the sea, every route carries with it the sense of a history written on water. Cruises and boats traverse landscapes that combine tradition and innovation: from the marine parks of the Wadden Sea to the reclaimed lands of Zeeland, passing by windswept islands where salt is still harvested by hand. A journey into the humid heart of Europe, where every voyage is a confrontation with the very essence of living.

We set sail from Harlingen, a historic port on the Wadden Sea, to explore one of Europe's most fascinating and little-known archipelagos. The first stop is Vlieland, the wildest and least populated island: no cars, just dunes, silence, and long bike paths through pine forests and sand. From there, we sail to Terschelling, where the pace is still that of the fishermen and the villages seem suspended in time. Here, you can meet local artisans, explore the Boschplaat nature reserve, and attend the open-air theater rehearsals that enliven the island in summer. We then continue to Ameland, rich in brick architecture, old mills, and coastal paths ideal for sunrise walks. The days pass between short dockings, nature excursions with local guides, visits to organic farms, and afternoons kayaking in the calm waters of the shallows. The last stop is Schiermonnikoog, an island national park where tourist traffic is strictly regulated and nature reigns supreme. Here, you can observe seal colonies and take part in guided explorations of the intertidal zones, veritable lunar landscapes that emerge at low tide.

On board, life is simple: you cook with local ingredients, read weather maps with the skipper, and every sunset is a solitary spectacle between sky and sand. A voyage that is also a journey through geography, time, and the silence of the Wadden Sea.


PRE-CRUISE EXPERIENCE

Three nights in **Zierikzee**, a medieval town surrounded by sea and glasswort fields, provide a graceful introduction to hidden **Zeeland**. Stay in former merchants' houses converted into small boutique hotels, explore canals, ramparts, and restored mills, and take excursions to the salt marshes of the **Schouwen-Duiveland** region. Saltwater cooking workshops, nature photography sessions, and guided tours of sustainable fish farms offer a rare cultural and environmental immersion. The pace is slow, punctuated by the sounds of the tides and the silent passage of boats along the canals. Harbor restaurants serve typical dishes such as Oosterschelde mussels and wild-seeded brown bread. Meetings with local botanists, strolls along the grassy dikes, and moments of relaxation in ancient wooden saunas complete a sensory and reflective introduction. Zeeland's open, luminous landscape prepares the eye for a voyage of continuous discovery, between nature and human ingenuity.



REASONS TO GO

The cruise departs from Middelburg, an ancient trading town now a vibrant center of art and urban sustainability, and travels along the coasts and estuaries of Zeeland, stopping at little-known yet extraordinarily significant locations. It reaches Veere, a 15th-century village where time and water seem to coexist in perfect balance, and then Tholen, a town surrounded by cultivated fields below sea level, known for its fish market and scenic cycle paths. A key stop is Neeltje Jans, the heart of the Delta Works project, where you can visit the interactive museum on hydraulic engineering and walk on the dikes that protect the town from flooding. The voyage continues through water towns like Goes and Yerseke, where you can taste oysters straight from the farms and meet the local community committed to protecting coastal ecosystems. On board, you'll find entertainment with environmental guides, and menus featuring regional products, with stops at smaller ports, leisurely guided tours, and days marked by the light and tides.
