NORTHERN ICELAND - NORTH ICELAND

BETWEEN SLEEPING VOLCANOES, NATURAL SCIENCE, AND A CULTURE OF RESILIENCE

Northern Iceland is an authentic and powerful region, where geological force merges with the identity of communities accustomed to living with the unpredictable. Cities like Akureyri and Húsavík offer a rare balance between extreme nature and vibrant culture, with museums, theaters, and scientific observatories. The landscapes are vast, with lava plateaus, ancient waterfalls, and thermal springs. Here, the educational experience is profound and multisensory, perfect for study trips, educational missions, and research programs.

ACCESSIBILITY AND HOSPITALITY

The north is connected by domestic flights and scenic routes from Reykjavik. Accommodations include eco-lodges, welcoming guesthouses, and research centers that host groups in a functional and immersive setting. Eastern Iceland is the most secluded and contemplative part of the country. Dominated by deep fjords, artisan villages, and ancient mountains, Austurland is a slow-paced region, ideal for those seeking productive silence, profound retreat, and authentic cohesion. Local communities are welcoming and rooted in a strong material culture: wool, wood, and oral storytelling. The landscape invites reflection, planning, and a return to the essential.

ACCESSIBILITY AND HOSPITALITY

Accessible by road from the south or north, or by domestic flights to Egilsstaðir. The accommodations are discreet and well-maintained: guesthouses, artist residences, and small hotels immersed in nature. Ideal for small groups, interdisciplinary experiences, and experimental MICE projects.

EXPERIENCES THAT INSPIRE AND UNITE

Contemplative walks among the fjords, storytelling workshops with artisans, local research projects with environmental experts. Programs can be created that combine work on vision and culture, symbolic excursions, and hands-on activities. An intimate and quiet space where ideas can mature without rushing.

- Spring (April–May): creative residencies, cultural projects, and regeneration activities.
- Summer (June-August): nature workshops, community programs, outdoor experiences.
- Autumn (September–October): slow meetings, educational programs, team retreats.
- Winter (November-March): indoor workshops, strategic retreats, symbolic experiences.



WESTERN ICELAND – VESTURLAND

BETWEEN CREATIVE INNOVATION, GEOPARKS AND CONTEMPORARY CULTURE

West Iceland blends urbanity and nature, innovation and myth. Reykjavik, a vibrant and experimental city, is a starting point for exploring remote peninsulas like Snæfellsnes and the Westfjords. This region intersects science, art, and entrepreneurship, with events, festivals, and initiatives involving professionals, scholars, and creatives from around the world. It's the perfect location for contemporary, multidisciplinary MICE.

ACCESSIBILITY AND HOSPITALITY

Keflavík International Airport is the main gateway to the country. The hotel offering is extensive and high-quality, with conference spaces, design hotels, co-working spaces, and unconventional event venues. Even in the most remote areas (such as the fjords) there are facilities suitable for small groups and immersive workshops.

EXPERIENCES THAT INSPIRE AND UNITE

Conferences in the city, art workshops in old ports, retreats among extinct volcanoes or in natural hot springs. Collaborations with universities, startups, and cultural foundations are possible. The experiences combine exploration, lateral thinking, and well-being. The West is dynamic, fertile, and constantly evolving.

- Spring (April–May): cultural events, innovative programs, festivals, and creative gatherings.
- Summer (June-August): hybrid conferences, educational trips, team building between nature and culture.
- Autumn (September–October): interdisciplinary workshops, institutional seminars, corporate retreats.
- Winter (November-March): indoor events, thematic workshops, academic or artistic residencies.



SOUTH ICELAND - SUÐURLAND

BETWEEN GLACIERS, ANCIENT NARRATIVES AND ICONIC LANDSCAPES

Southern Iceland is the country's most recognizable and photographed face: geysers, volcanoes, waterfalls, and glacial expanses alternate, creating visually striking and symbolic scenes. This region is home to Þingvellir (the world's oldest parliament), the Vatnajökull glacier, and the spectacular coast of Vik. Ideal for emotional and educational events, the southern region connects environment, history, and innovation in a continuous journey of wonder and awareness.

ACCESSIBILITY AND HOSPITALITY

Easily accessible from Reykjavik, the region is well-served by roads and facilities to accommodate organized groups. Eco-friendly resorts, rural hotels, and outdoor event spaces complete the offerings. The region is flexible, adaptable, and captivating in every season.

EXPERIENCES THAT INSPIRE AND UNITE

Team-building activities on glaciers, reflective meetings at the foot of waterfalls, storytelling workshops in historic villages. It's possible to create experiential itineraries combining environment and history, with symbolic stops and interdisciplinary content: geology, sustainability, Viking history, and contemporary creativity naturally intertwine.

- Spring (April–May): educational trips, outdoor activities, sustainable events.
- Summer (June-August): emotional incentives, nature retreats, experiential training.
- Autumn (September-October): immersive storytelling, creative workshops, cultural encounters.
- Winter (November-March): reflection events, indoor sessions, symbolic experiences in the snow.



ITINERARY - INTEGRATED MICE

DAY 1 – REYKJAVIK: NORDIC CREATIVITY AND FLUID CONNECTIONS

We begin in **Reykjavik**, a vibrant and intimate capital city, where the essential becomes aesthetic. The group meets in a conference center overlooking the sea, built entirely of basalt glass. The kickoff is dynamic, with fluid sessions alternating inspirational speeches, moments of co-creation, and visual stimuli. The lunch break is a Nordic-style food tour, exploring local flavors and new gastronomic trends. The evening concludes with a private dinner in a contemporary art gallery, amidst light installations and live acoustic music. It's only the first act, but the energy has already shifted.

DAY 2 – GOLDEN CIRCLE: NATURAL POWER AND STRATEGIC VISION

The second day is an immersion in the beating heart of Iceland. We set off for the Golden Circle: Thingvellir, where tectonic plates separate; Geysir, where the earth breathes; and Gullfoss, where water expresses its power. The team works outdoors, in shifting stages between nature and thought. Each location becomes a stimulus to explore change: personal, corporate, and collective. After lunch in a geothermal greenhouse, the afternoon is dedicated to workshops on regenerative leadership. In the evening, dinner is served in an eco-lodge surrounded by silence and moss, with a tasting of geothermal products and an informal lesson on sustainability and innovation.

DAY 3 – SOUTH COAST: CHALLENGE, BEAUTY, AND UNITY

The group travels along the southern coast, where the landscape becomes epic. Black beaches, exposed cliffs, distant glaciers: this is where a high-impact team-building activity takes shape. They hike along ancient paths, work together to cross a canyon, and undertake symbolic challenges to overcome obstacles. Lunch is served in a converted barn, featuring local products and storytelling from the chefs. In the afternoon, a moment of reconciliation among the rocks, while the Atlantic waves crash: everyone finds their own key word. The day ends in a design hotel in the middle of nowhere, with a slow, reflective dinner under the Nordic sky.

DAY 4 – BLUE LAGOON: REGENERATION, VIEWING, AND LISTENING

The fourth day is dedicated to body and mind. We head to the **Blue Lagoon** for an immersive retreat: the group is divided between sessions in the panoramic room and wellness rituals in the geothermal water. Here, time slows down and our vision broadens. After a light lunch, a guided future thinking session takes place, in which each participant visualizes their role in future changes. The afternoon is free, with massages, relaxation, silence, and spontaneous conversations. The final dinner is held in a lava cave, decorated with warm lighting, Nordic music, and dishes that tell the story of the island: a solemn and intimate conclusion.

DAY 5 - REYKJAVIK: SUMMARY, VISION, AND NEW MAPS

We return to the capital for one last moment together. In a small renovated theater, the group gathers to share insights, emotions, and images. Each participant leaves a phrase on a large collective board, thus creating a symbolic map of the journey. The final brunch is served in an urban greenhouse surrounded by plants and glass, where the atmosphere is light and full of promise. When the group parts ways, they do so with gratitude, clarity, and a new sense of direction. Iceland is not just a destination, but an accelerator of awareness.

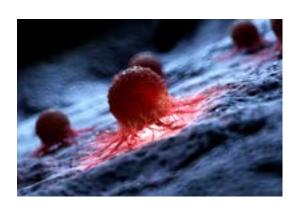
