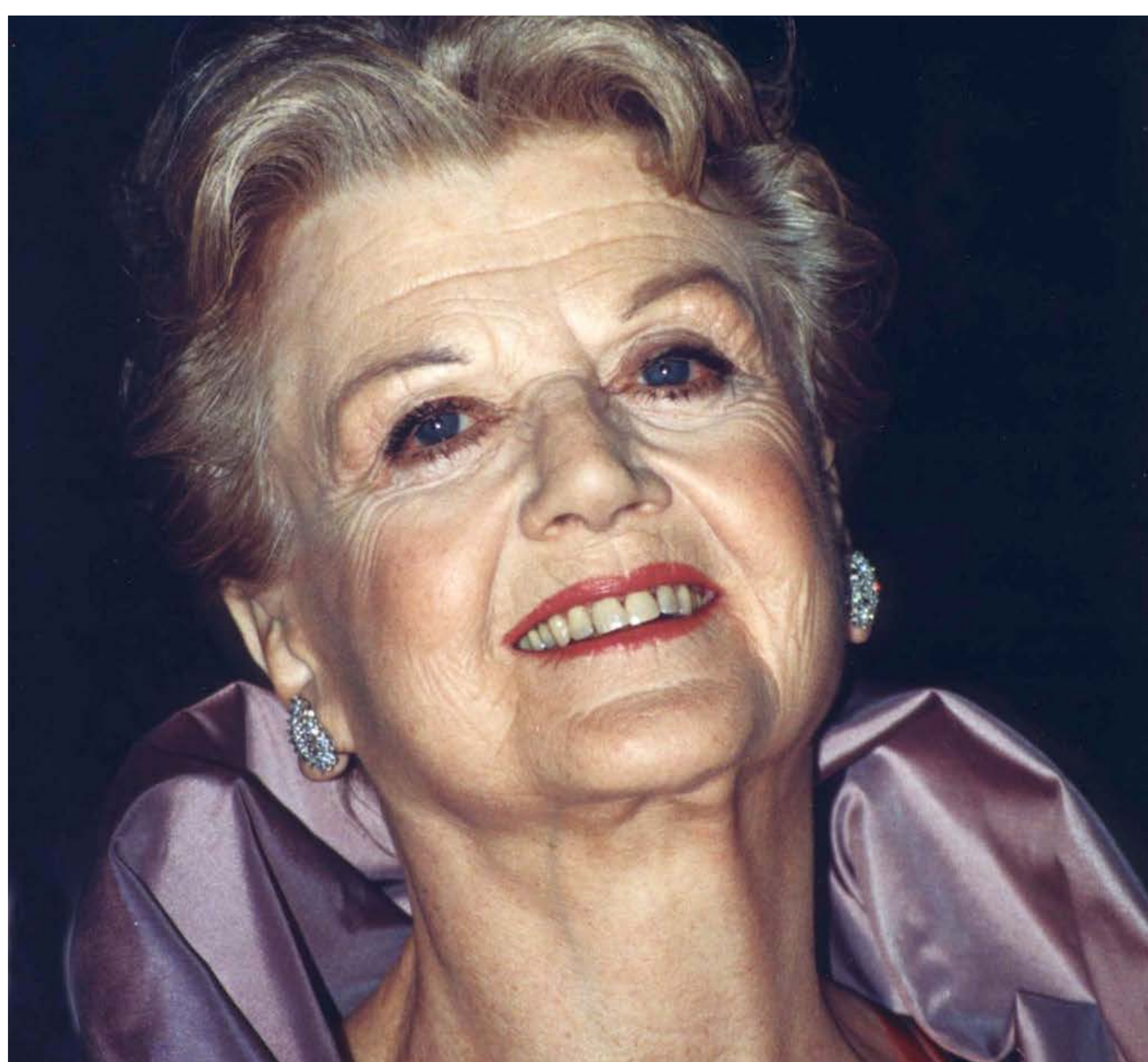




# DISCOVER NEW ENGLAND REGION - USA
