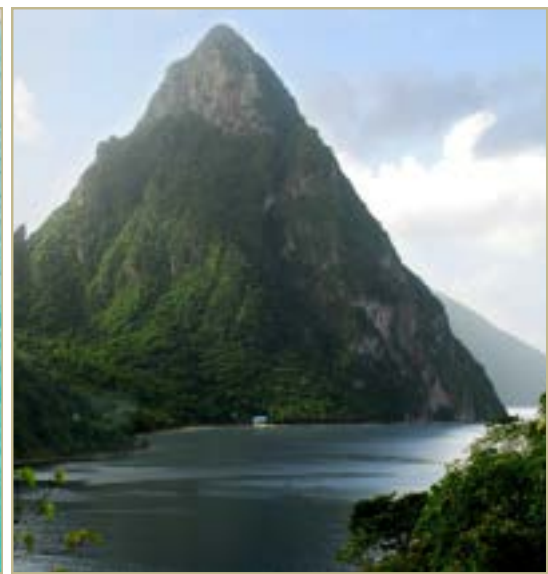

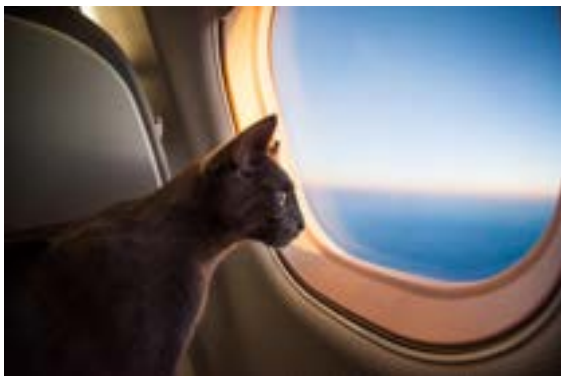

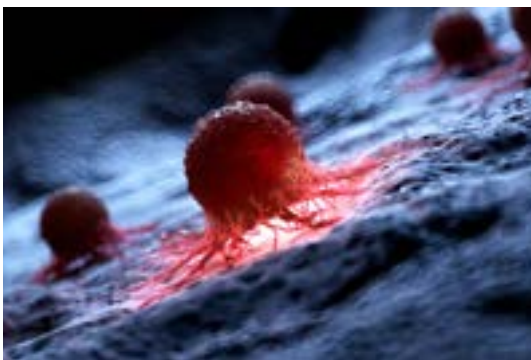

BETWEEN REBELLIOUS WATERS, DEEP IDENTITIES AND ISLANDS THAT TELL STORIES

The Greater Antilles are more than an archipelago: they are a constantly evolving mosaic of histories, languages, and cultures. Sailing between Cuba, Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, and the Cayman Islands means brushing coastlines marked by a colonial past, connecting with vibrant and resilient communities, and discovering a travel rhythm that speaks of music, resistance, and everyday beauty.

Boats navigate routes through hidden bays, waterside villages, and colorful cities where history dances among the squares and markets. Cruises offer alternative destinations, far from the most crowded tourist routes, allowing for authentic encounters: a floating laboratory of cultures, memories, and future visions.

Each island is a chapter: Cuba with its timeless architecture, Puerto Rico with its urban resilience and wild nature, the Virgin Islands with seabeds to explore and proudly welcoming communities. Here, the ocean does not separate, but unites. And sailing becomes an act of listening, discovery, and respect.





CUBA AND CAYMAN - BETWEEN CORAL REEFS, FORGOTTEN ISLANDS AND WATER HORIZONS

Far from crowded beaches and large resorts, the **Greater Antilles** offer an intimate voyage through warm, clear waters, small uninhabited islands, and communities that still maintain a slow, authentic pace. Departing from the southern coast of **Cuba**, embarkation takes place in **Cienfuegos**, an elegant colonial city overlooking a sheltered bay, perfect for your first nights at anchor. The route opens toward the **Canarreos archipelago**, touching **Cayo Guano del Este**, **Cayo Largo**, and **Cayo Sigua**, where the sand is white, marine life abounds, and time seems suspended. Snorkel among colorful fish, explore small brackish lagoons inhabited by coastal birds, and enjoy lunch on deserted beaches under woven palm huts. Halfway along the itinerary, you cross the route to the **Cayman Islands**, where the arrival on **Cayman Brac** surprises with its tranquility. Here, you disembark to visit windswept cliffs, limestone caves, and small towns where a rare authenticity still reigns. The excursion into the island's interior offers trails among cacti, colonial history, and natural refuges for rare birds. The voyage continues to **Little Cayman**, the most remote and fascinating island: only a few dozen inhabitants, spectacular seabeds, and a fragile and precious ecosystem. Guided dives in the **Bloody Bay Wall**, kayaking at sunset, and a final anchorage in a secluded bay complete the journey with pure and silent emotions. A week away from it all, on a stretch of sea that combines nature, culture, and contemplation.

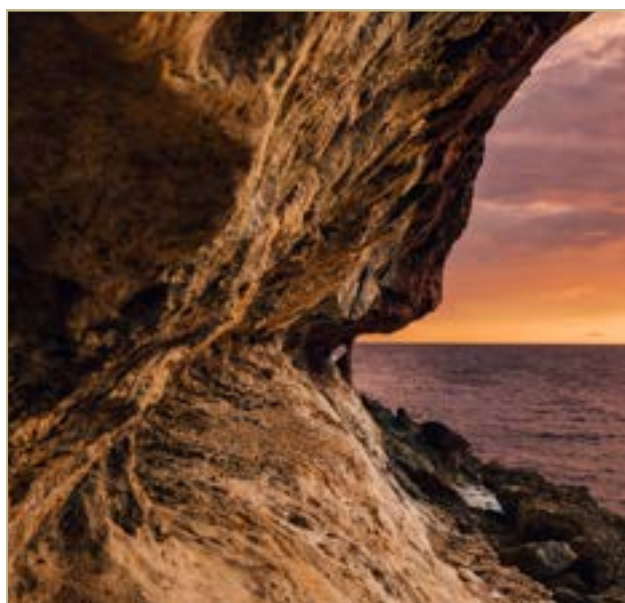

Before setting sail, treat yourself to three nights in the interior of **Pinar del Río**, in western **Cuba**, a true sanctuary of nature and tradition. You'll stay in a historic finca nestled among the iconic mogote hills and vast tobacco plantations, where you can discover ancient tobacco processing techniques, explore trails on foot or on horseback through enchanting valleys, and enjoy traditional dinners accompanied by traditional music. Evenings under starry skies will regale you with tales of resilience and rural pride, preparing you for a cruise that transcends the Caribbean.



REASONS TO GO

This cruise explores a lesser-known part of the Greater Antilles, sailing between the **Canarreos Archipelago (Cuba)**, the **Cayman Islands**, and—on select departures—the southern coast of Cuba to **Santiago**, or the islands of the **Gulf of Batabanó**. Far from major ports of call, you'll dock in quiet bays where time passes slowly: villages with ancient rhythms, seaside markets, wind-bent palm trees, and live music played in small plazas. Days are punctuated by cultural excursions, swimming in turquoise waters, and diving among shipwrecks and coral reefs. On board, life is relaxed: dine under the stars, take Caribbean cooking classes, or participate in meetings with local scholars on historical and environmental topics. Each stop is a story: from the dolphins spotted off **Cayo Largo** to the Creole spirituality of **Cayman Brac**, to the revolutionary echoes of **Cuba's** southern coast. A journey for those who love to sail slowly, listen and observe, allowing themselves to be surprised by another idea of the Caribbean.

NORTHERN LESSER ANTILLES

BETWEEN SHARED WATERS, LIVING MEMORIES AND LABORATORY ISLANDS

The Northern Lesser Antilles are a crossroads of intertwined histories and interconnected cultures, where each island holds traces of complex pasts and dreams of the future. Sailing between Anguilla, Saint Martin, and Saint Barthélemy means immersing yourself in protected landscapes, artisan villages, and communities that preserve memories of struggle and resilience.

The routes favor lesser-traveled landings, among hidden bays and authentic ports, offering travelers a deep immersion in nature and traditions. Here, the sea is a thread that unites sovereign territories and shares heritage, while sailing becomes a practice of discovery and collaboration.

Each stop is an invitation to observe social and environmental transformations, to engage with shifting cultures, and to participate in sustainability and community development projects. A journey where the small becomes great, and the island tells stories worth preserving and passing on.

Far from mass tourism, the Lesser Antilles reveal an archipelago rich in protected nature and ancient traditions, best discovered by sailing through calm, clear waters. Start from **Sint Maarten**, a cosmopolitan island with a well-equipped port and artisan markets, perfect for a first encounter with Creole culture.

The route continues to **Anguilla**, where hidden beaches and fishing villages offer a secluded and authentic atmosphere. Here you can hike along coastal paths or dive into uncrowded bays, amidst intense colors and authentic silence.

The journey then heads to **Saint Barthélemy**, whose sheltered bays and small art museums tell a story of creativity and French roots. From there, we sail to **Saint Kitts**, where forgotten plantations, nature parks, and welcoming communities offer off-the-beaten-path experiences.

Halfway through the journey, you'll arrive in **Nevis**, a lush and tranquil island, ideal for walks through forests and hot springs, in an atmosphere of relaxation and regeneration. The next stop is **Montserrat**, an island marked by the powerful nature of its volcano, with reconstructed villages and a powerful cultural heritage.

The voyage continues to **Redonda**, an uninhabited island offering the thrill of wild nature and the chance to spot rare species. The final day concludes in **St. Maarten**, with time to explore artisan workshops and savor the local cuisine.

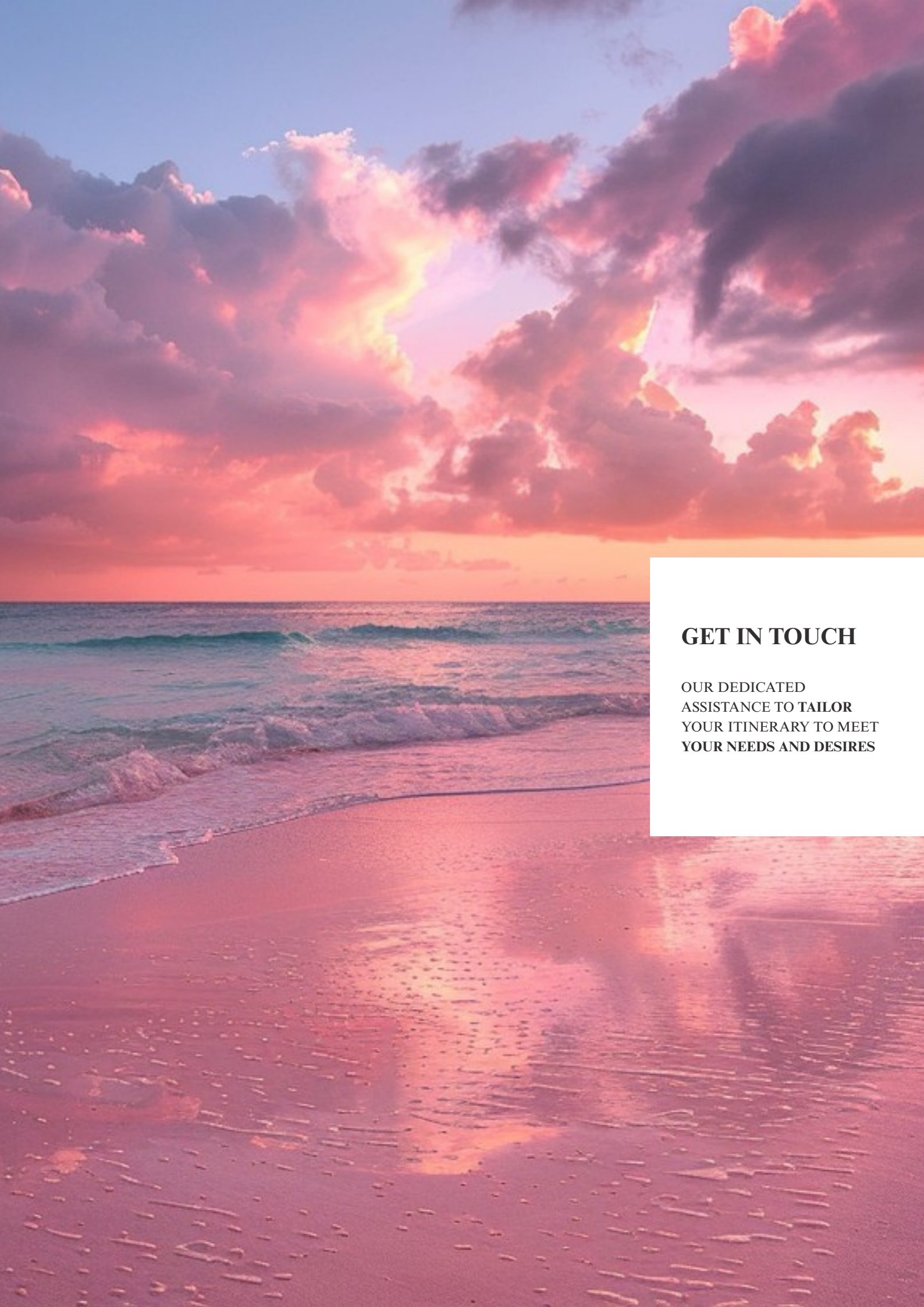
