



WHY VISIT


Canada is considered by extension, the second largest country in the world after Russia. This huge country is bordered to the south by the United States and to the northwest by Alaska. Furthermore, the seas that surround it are the Arctic Ocean to the north, the Atlantic Ocean to the east and the Pacific Ocean to the west. It is very interesting to know its history relating to the native Algonquian, Iroquois, Cayuga, Inuit populations and to the past events connected with British and French colonialism. It has large energy resources such as gas, oil and raw metals, and strong and at the same time stable economy.











These extraordinary islands of pink and white beaches are located in the North Atlantic Ocean approximately 1780 miles east of the coast of the United States of America. The territory consists of over 130 islands and islets of volcanic rock and coral formations with crystalline sea and a warm climate. Discovered by Juan de Bermudez in 1515, a Spanish navigator and subsequently colonized by the English, they are not only a place to relax but also to visit monuments and sites connected with the English dominion and learn more about the local populations


















Greenland was first explored by Viking navigators during the 10th century AD. and was occupied by the Danes in 1380.

Today the island has effective self-government, although the Head of State is still the Queen of Denmark.

It has deposits of cryolite and lignite. After the Second World War it played an important role in weather forecasting and in controlling the routes that cross the North Atlantic and the Arctic Ocean. The local populations of Eskimos (Inuit), live in small villages located mainly along the western coasts

















CENTRAL AMERICA CARIBBEAN

WHY VISIT

This vast geographical region made up of more than 7,000 islands includes all the countries surrounded by the Caribbean Sea.

Its historical past is mainly connected with British, French and Dutch colonialism but also with Spain, Malta and Denmark and local populations with their arts and traditions













NORTH EUROPE UNITED KINGDOM

WHY VISIT

An island nation in Western Europe surrounded by the North Sea to the east, the English Channel to the south and the Atlantic Ocean to the west. It was the first state in the world to be industrialized and to have exercised great influence in many countries over the past centuries with its colonialism. It has a diverse Anglo-Saxon, Norman, Caribbean and Asian population. The country is rich in reserves of coal, gas and oil. It owns many banks, insurance companies and financial services.

The culture of the United Kingdom has been influenced by several factors among which the nation's island status stands out; its Western liberal democratic history and a major power, as well as from being a political union of four countries each with different elements and independent traditions and home to leading scientists and popular musical styles













NORTH EUROPE IRELAND

WHY VISIT

This country is bordered to the west by the Atlantic Ocean and to the northeast by the North Channel.

Initially it was occupied by the Celtic populations and later it was under English rule and in the last century it gained independence.

In small towns and villages it is still possible to go back in time and relive stories related to Celtic culture and attend ancient music performances. It is also home of two worldfamous writers: James Joyce and Oscar Wilde. The computer and technology sector has recently had a notable development








NORTH EUROPE FAROE ISLANDS







WHY VISIT

Archipelago of 18 islands of volcanic rock off the northern coast of Europe, between the Norwegian Sea and the north Atlantic Ocean, midway between Iceland and Scotland. They were settled by the Norse and remained under their rule until the end of the 14th century. Later they were under Swedish and Danish control but in the last century they became independent. In small centers and towns it is possible to visit Scandinavian attractions and enjoy the traditions and events typical of the local inhabitants








NORTH EUROPE ICELAND






Initially inhabited by Irish monks, it was later colonized by the Norwegians. Subsequently it became part of the domains of the Danes until it reached independence in the last century

Iceland's culture is rich and diverse, as well as being known for its literary heritage written by authors who lived from the 12th to the 14th century. Other traditional Icelandic arts include weaving, silver jewelry and wood carving. The Reykjavík area features several theaters, a symphony orchestra, an opera house and a large number of art galleries, bookstores, cinemas and museums.

















NORTH EUROPE NORWAY

WHY VISIT

This country borders Sweden to the east and Finland and Russia to the north-east, while the Skagerrak separates it from Denmark to the south. Maritime borders are north on the Arctic Ocean and the Barents Sea, west on the Atlantic Ocean (Norwegian Sea), south on the North Sea (Skagerrak)

Home of the Vikings. It was later part of several unions with Sweden and Denmark until it achieved its independence last century. It is a country with a very prosperous economy thanks to the wealth of gas and oil. Its small villages and towns allow you to come into contact with customs and traditions related to the local population














NORTH EUROPE SWEDEN

WHY VISIT

This nation borders Norway to the west and Finland to the northeast. The country's boundaries include the Baltic Sea and the Gulf of Bothnia to the east and the Skagerrak and Kattegat straits to the southwest. The internal territory is mostly occupied by forests. Sweden has over 220,000 islands, more than any other country in the world. Originally inhabited by the Vikings, it was later under Danish power and later gained independence in 1523

Currently the city boasts the longest art gallery in the world located in the Stockholm Metro, which was built around the 1950s. Even the Vasa Museum gives the place a not indifferent historical cultural heritage, in particular because it exhibits the remains of the Vasa ship recovered a few years after the construction of the metro and rich in historical value.













NORTH EUROPE FINLAND

WHY VISIT

The land borders of this country are Sweden to the west, Norway to the north and Russia to the east while the maritime borders are the Gulf of Finland to the south, the Baltic Sea to the southwest and the Gulf of Bothnia to the west. It is famous for its large number of lakes, around 180,000. The coast is indented and has numerous bays and inlets.

In the north-eastern part of the country extends Lapland, the land of the tundra, inhabited not only by the Finns, but also by a Sami minority, whose main activity is reindeer breeding.

Among the oldest architectural monuments there are some medieval castles and about seventy stone churches located in the southern part of the country mainly along the coast.







NORTH EUROPE NETHERLANDS







WHY VISIT

The land and sea borders of this country are with Belgium in the south and with Germany in the east. To the north and west it is bordered by the North Sea. They had a vast colonial empire which, at the time of its greatest expansion (17th century), was the leading world trading power.

Initially under Roman, Germanic and Napoleonic rule and later independent. Its main morphological characteristic is the flatness of the territory (about half of the territory is less than one meter above sea level)

Particular attractions are the navigable channels, tulip fields and windmills. The great use of the bicycle is famous and finally a multicultural population with a very open and tolerant mentality.













SOUTH WEST EUROPE SPAIN

WHY VISIT

The land borders of this nation are to the north-east with France (from which it is separated by the chain of the Pyrenees) and Andorra, to the south with the British possession of Gibraltar, to the west with Portugal and, through its exclaves of Ceuta and Melilla, with Morocco. Its maritime borders are the Atlantic Ocean to the north and the Mediterranean Sea to the south.

Its Mediterranean and subtropical climate guarantees mild temperatures all year round. Its population is very lively, cheerful and friendly. Numerous peoples and cultures such as Celts, Romans, Phoenicians, Arabs have left an incomparable cultural heritage throughout the country, from thousands of years ago until today. This country possesses an incomparable monumental richness, the result of the meeting of cultures and centuries of history. In the country that gave birth to universal artists such as Velázquez, Goya, Gaudí, Picasso, and Dalí, art and culture are lived intensely and in many ways.













SOUTH WEST EUROPE PORTUGAL

WHY VISIT

This country borders only with Spain and its coasts are on the Atlantic Ocean. Its geographical position has allowed it in the past to exercise a vast colonial domain.

In ancient times it was occupied by the Lusitani tribe and later it was part of the Roman and Muslim Empire

The cities are famous for their beautiful palaces and monuments in a style that mixes Gothic and Renaissance with azulejos, the typical tiles with which the palaces are decorated.

The icy turquoise water of the ocean alternates with soaring cliffs and jaw-dropping sea caves with enchanting beaches













SOUTH EUROPE ITALY

WHY VISIT

Its land borders are from west to east, with France, Switzerland, Austria and Slovenia. This juts out into the Mediterranean Sea, surrounded by the Ligurian, Tyrrhenian, Ionian and Adriatic seas.

In the past, the peninsula welcomed highly civilized populations, such as the Phoenicians and the Greeks, who founded prosperous colonies on its coasts. For a long time politically divided among a multitude of different states, largely subject to foreign rule

It has countless tourist attractions such as glorious gardens, historic villages and towns, emerald lakes, opera music, extraordinary and varied food and drink, fashion, a large and varied architecture of churches monasteries, Roman and Etruscan monuments, Renaissance palaces and squares, museums and galleries. Finally splendid, beaches, sea and islands













SOUTH ISLAND EUROPE MALTA

WHY VISIT

Archipelago located in the Mediterranean, in the Malta channel. It is known for its warm climate. It has beautiful historic buildings, old churches, cliffs, villages and beaches. It is also famous for the historic sites connected to the various rulers of the island, from the Romans, the Moors, the Knights of St John, the French and the English.













SOUTH EUROPE GREECE


WHY VISIT

This nation is bordered by Albania, North Macedonia, Bulgaria and Turkey to the north and its maritime borders on the other sides by the Aegean Sea, the Ionian Sea and the Cretan Sea.

It is a country rich in history and monuments. The Greeks created one of the finest cultures in the ancient world. They have invented theater and philosophy, splendid works of art such as bronze and marble statues modeled by various sculptors and music was also widespread and accompanied with the reading of poems. Today it is still possible to admire all this.







NORTH - AFRICA EGYPT



WHY VISIT

This country is bordered by the Mediterranean Sea to the north, the Gaza Strip and Israel to the northeast, the Gulf of Aqaba and the Red Sea to the east, Sudan to the south and Libya to the west.

A fascinating land full of history and mysteries left by the ancient Egyptians in the various monuments: pyramids, the sphinx, the ruins of the Pharaonic era, temples and countless archaeological sites.

Finally there are the luxurious beach resorts on the Red Sea for total rest and relaxation











EAST - AFRICA SEYCHELLES







WHY VISIT

Island state of 115 islands in the Indian Ocean.

They were initially under French and then British rule but later independent. In the islands the main cultural attraction is constituted by the customs and traditions of the local inhabitants

Magnificent coastal landscapes, warm turquoise waters, fine white sand and palm trees. Spectacular nature of huge trees, exotic flowers and tropical fruits. Fantastic animals such as giant turtles, tropical birds, fish and corals













EAST - AFRICA MAURITIUS

WHY VISIT

Island state in the Indian Ocean formerly used by Portuguese navigators as a support base to reach Java and later a Dutch, French and finally British colony

Extraordinary multi-ethnic atmosphere that sees different people, foods, languages and traditions coexist peacefully among African, European and Asian components. Culture characterized by dances and traditions such as the traditional Sèga dance with captivating rhythms danced by women with full and colorful skirts

Finally Crystal clear sea, very fine white beaches, giant water lilies, splendid eucalyptus trees, palm trees













SOUTH EAST - AFRICA ZANZIBAR

WHY VISIT

Archipelago located in the Indian Ocean. Originally the insular territory was inhabited by Bantu coming from the coast who began to cultivate the land and work iron, always organized in villages and clans. It was later a central point for Arab and Persian trade, whose routes linked the Middle East to India and China. Subsequently these islands were under Portuguese, Sultanate of Oman and British rule until independence in the last century.

The islands have a sad historical past associated with the collection and sale of all slaves from East Africa, captured on the continent and brought to Zanzibar to be placed on the colony market.

Its characteristic aspects are the long stretches of very thin and very white sand, waters are crystal clear and the color of the sea varies according to the area and reaches dazzling shades, the streets smell of spices and finally the population is smiling and welcoming













MIDDLE EAST - ASIA ISRAEL PALESTINE

WHY VISIT

The nation of Israel is bordered by Lebanon to the north, Syria to the northeast, Jordan to the east, Egypt to the southwest, the Gulf of Aqaba to the south, and the Palestinian territories, i.e. the West Bank (comprising the historical regions of Judea and Samaria) to the east, and the Gaza Strip to the southwest. The maritime border is the Mediterranean Sea.

A direct contact with the places that are part of the sacred biblical history relating to Judaism, Solomon, the Kingdom of Judea and Israel, the Assyrian - Babylonian conquest and Alexander the Great, the era of Christ and Roman rule







MIDDLE EAST - ASIA UNITED ARAB EMIRATES







WHY VISIT

The nation has a total of 7 emirates, borders Oman to the southeast, Saudi Arabia to the southwest, and the Persian Gulf to the north. Initially there were nothing but small villages dedicated to agriculture and pastoralism.

Subsequently Greeks, Persians and Muslims exercised their control. The first Bedouin settlements after the advent of Islam, took root in these places to slowly build what are now the great cities of Abu Dhabi and Dubai. Finally the emirates were formed and the grandiose economic development arrived with the discovery of the oil fields. It is interesting to learn more about the local Arab culture in the typical neighborhoods and mosques













SOUTH - ASIA MALDIVES

WHY VISIT

Island state in the Indian Ocean made up of a 1,190 coral grouped in a double chain of twenty-seven atolls

The original populations were expert sailors, of Buddhist religion with strong influences of Indian and Sri Lankan culture.

Over time the islands became an excellent staging post between the silk trade between Europe and Asia.

Later the country was under the rule of Islam and Portugal and finally after being a British protectorate it became independent.

Handicrafts, music and dances are the characteristic aspects of the local culture













EAST - ASIA JAPAN

WHY VISIT

Archipelago of more than 6,000 islands located in the Pacific Ocean The first populations to settle on the territory were both of Siberian - Manchurian origin and of Korean - southern Chinese origin.

The country has passed through various historical eras and each of them has brought something characteristic such as the working of ceramics in the Jomon period, the working of bronze, agricultural techniques and the burial of influential people in impressive tombs in the Yayoi period, the birth of samurai in the Heian period and the arts in the Edo period. In 1889 the first Japanese Constitution was promulgated and although the emperor is the head of state he does not have legislative, executive or judicial powers. Today it is possible to see all this in various monuments, museums, castles and temples







OCEANIA AUSTRALIA



The country is surrounded by the Indian Ocean to the west and south, and the Pacific to the east.

The Portuguese Cristóvão de Mendonça discovers Australia in 1522 and following this event the country is subject to British colonialism around 1770 which causes the death of many local aboriginal populations due to the diseases brought by the Europeans. At the beginning of the last century it becomes independent. Its culture relates to the customs and traditions of the aborigines but is otherwise typically Occidental















OCEANIA FRENCH POLYNESIA







WHY VISIT

This country has a total of 118 islands divided into 5 archipelagos in the South Pacific Ocean. Politically the islands of French Polynesia were divided into small kingdoms where English and French colonizers tried to seize the territory.

One of the most beautiful places in the world for the perfection and spectacular nature of the landscapes. The interior of the islands is rich in forests and spectacular waterfalls. The beaches and the sea are idyllic. Particularly suggestive are the shows associated with local traditions such as the one where the men perform the fire dance and the women in straw skirts dance the tamurè and everyone sings choirs at the end.


